## FIRST GRADE

- Pencils (#2) – 24 any brand/design (**NO** mechanical)
  - Crayons – 8 count **JUMBO** crayons (2 packs)
  - Glue – 3 Elmer’s **JUMBO** glue sticks (preferably disappearing purple glue)
  - Scissors – 1 pair of child scissors
  - Zipper Pencil Pouch – any design (**NO** plastic boxes, these will not fit in our supply crates)
  - Sticky Notes – 1 pack, any color (recommend: 3 in. x 3 in. or larger)
  - Dry Erase Markers – 4 Low odor **THIN** dry erase markers, any color
  - Composition Books – 3 **MEAD PRIMARY** 100 sheet story journal (usually blue with **blank on top** for picture, **lined on the bottom** for writing) – try Walmart, Target, or Staples
  - Erasers – 1 three pack of Pink Pearl Erasers
  - Highlighters – 2 any color
  - Boys – 1 box of FREEZER GALLON size plastic baggies and 1 pack of baby wipes
  - Girls – 1 box of plastic quart plastic baggies and 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
  - Water Bottle – 1 reusable plastic water bottle
