Tryout information

- Tryouts will be held when we are given the ok. It might be a virtual tryout. Tryouts begin at 4:30 p.m. and run until all are finished.
- Attire will be comfortable shorts (not too short). Girls will wear a skirt (provided by the school) over the shorts and character shoes. Boys will wear boots (or shoes with a hard sole) Girls-Hair should be in a ponytail or away from face if too short for a ponytail. No hair accessories or jewelry.
- Shirts will be white, no logo on it.
- You will be given a number, put it on a sheet of white paper and pin it to the front of your shirt.
- Candidates will audition in front of judges. This might be done virtually.
- Callbacks may be necessary so be prepared
- Remember that your teacher recommendations count.
- Points will be **deducted** for a negative discipline and/or teacher report.
- You will be judged on the following categories: Knowledge of routine, Timing and Rhythm, movement and technique, projection and Showmanship, and Overall Presentation.
- Reminder that the judges score the candidates and **NOT** the Director
- It is each candidate's responsibility to do their very best.
- The decision of the judges will be final with no appeals.

Tryouts are *CLOSED*. The only persons allowed besides the participants will be the Director, senior dancers, and during tryouts, the judges.
