Launched in August 2014, boarding at Stonehill was developed as a contemporary and adaptive programme, designed to cater to the modern and fast-evolving residential lifestyle of full-time and weekly boarding students.

From academic support to pastoral and residential care as well as experiencing new social situations and living with others from a range of cultural backgrounds — SIS boarding opens a new world to a young person. From 8 boarders in 2014, Stonehill Boarding has now grown to a close-knit community of almost 60 boarders in 2019. With the increase in full-time boarders, the weekend activities programme is one that is constantly evolving and growing. This year, Stonehill Boarders have been involved in a variety of activities and initiatives like the Sustainable Garden that provides produce to the cafeteria; movie nights in the pool; weekend outings for laser tag, bowling, shopping and more; kite flying afternoons and bonfire nights; self-defence workshop by Safe Campus; the Trashion Show and multiple team building activities in the new Sports Hall.
