This year we celebrate our 10 Year Anniversary. We now have over over 500 students representing almost 40 nationalities. We completed the last academic year with a very pleasing set of IB Diploma examination results. Our average scores remained above the world average for the sixth consecutive year and we are delighted to have sent our graduating class to some excellent universities. Students from the graduating class of 2018 were accepted into universities that included Stanford University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), London School of Economics (LSE) and McGill University.

We are now an established three programme IB World School and our graduates are heading into life beyond school equipped with the skills needed for the rapidly evolving 21st century workplace.

# Message from the Head of School

This year we improved our already impressive facilities with the addition of a purpose-built Sports Hall. Our students are all now enjoying the use of this fantastic addition to the Stonehill Campus.

This academic year we also hosted IB, CIS and NEASC evaluation teams for a Synchronised Evaluation Visit. This is a process that happens every five years. The International Baccalaureate Evaluation takes place to ensure that the standards and practices of IB programmes (PYP, MYP and DP) are being maintained. Accreditation with Council of International Schools and New England Association of Schools and Colleges show that a school has achieved high standards of professional performance in international education and has a commitment to continuous improvement. We were delighted with the outcome of the evaluations. We have been re-accredited by CIS and NEASC and we continue to be authorised to offer all three IB programmes. Below, you can read some of the highlights from the evaluation reports.

# Stonehill's Grade 12 Students get Excellent Scores Once Again

Stonehill International School, known for its diverse and inclusive culture, continues to move from strength to strength. With an average pass rate of 34 points and an overall average of 32.1 points, Stonehill's International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) score remains above the world average, for the sixth consecutive year.

Of the graduating Class of 2018, two of Stonehill's graduates received an excellent result of 42 out of a maximum score of 45 points.

This small cohort of 26 students have collectively earned scholarships worth over \$250,000.

Simon McCloskey, the Head of School says, "As an inclusive school, striving to develop caring, confident and responsible global citizens, we are delighted that Stonehill's average IB Diploma results have now been consistently above the world average for the past six years. We are also extremely pleased that two of our students, Dilsher Singh and



Vinicius De Paula Sousa, both achieved 42 points — our highest score this year. We are all extremely proud of the Stonehill Graduating Class of 2018. We know that our very special students will go on to achieve great things."


Here's what some of this year's graduates have to say about the IB Diploma Programme and the school:

# Stonehill Celebrates 10 Years of Excellence with a 10k Run

On September 23<sup>rd</sup>, Stonehill International School hosted a 10K running event to celebrate the school's 10-year anniversary. The event was organised by Life is Calling Sports. Ms Deepa Bhat, the first Indian woman to successfully complete the tough Everest Marathon, participated in the 35K event. Mr Thomas Bobby Philip, the first runner to successfully complete the prestigious Boston Marathon by running barefoot, won the 35K run in the Men's category. Mr Raghunath Bylahalli, who successfully completed the 10K run, was the oldest participant at 85 years!



The event also saw Stonehill staff and students participate enthusiastically in the 10K and 5K runs. Mr Jitu Virwani, Founder of Stonehill International School, flagged off the run and attended the prize distribution ceremony along with Mr Simon McCloskey, Head of School.



Mr. McCloskey also participated and successfully completed the 10K run. "We encourage our students to live a balanced and healthy life. It was great to see students, parents and teachers participating in this fantastic event" he said.



#### ISTA Drama Festival in New Delhi

On the morning of September 26<sup>th</sup>, nineteen students from M1 up to M3 and two teachers travelled to New Delhi to Participate in the annual ISTA Drama Festival.

The festival also allowed our students to form friendships with students of other participating schools.

In the final performance our students exceeded all expectations with their confidence and focus. All of them performed with charm and swagger that spoke of how comfortable they all felt in their own skin. Mr Sanger, Secondary Drama Teacher says, "Teachers from other schools remarked how visible this self-esteem was in our students and were eager to know what caused it. ### Google India Summit

The Stonehill International School learning community was proud to host India's first Google Summit in Bangalore with AppsEvents 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2018. This fantastic professional development opportunity included participants from ten schools across Bangalore, including our very own Stonehill staff. The first day was dedicated to three Bootcamps — Level 1 and 2 Certification for Educators and Level 1 Certification for Support Staff in Schools.





On 17th and 18th, teachers and trainers from around Asia came together to learn new things, share strategies for teaching and learning and find the inspiration to continually improve their practice. Participants visited The Great Barrier Reef through Virtual Reality and Google Expeditions, became data masters with Google Forms, Sheets, and Data Studio, explored their artistic sides with Google Drawings, and so much more. At the core of the sessions were the questions, "How do students learn best?" and "How can we use technology to make learning happen better?"

"The sessions and speakers brought tons of exciting and practical ideas that got my brain whirling with the possibilities. Teachers were buzzing all weekend about the new ideas they wanted to take back to their classrooms." explained Whole School Technology Coordinator and event organiser, Ms Katie Steen. "Providing this kind of experience for our teachers supports them to fulfil our school's stated mission of providing enhanced opportunities for technological innovation," added Head of School, Mr Simon McCloskey.

The IB report successfully identifies many of our strengths and accomplishments and also provides us with some useful recommendations to help us further focus on the growth and development of

our school as we move into our next cycle of reflection, review and action planning.

The award of the CIS accreditation shows that our school has achieved high standards of professional performance in international education and is committed to continuous improvement. The CIS Evaluation Report that we received is extremely positive and enables us to celebrate our achievements. It also provides useful recommendations that will help us to identify improvements that can be made to further support student learning and wellbeing.

The External Review Report that we received from NEASC enables us to highlight and celebrate our achievements. It also provides suggestions that will help us improve the quality of learning and teaching at our school.
