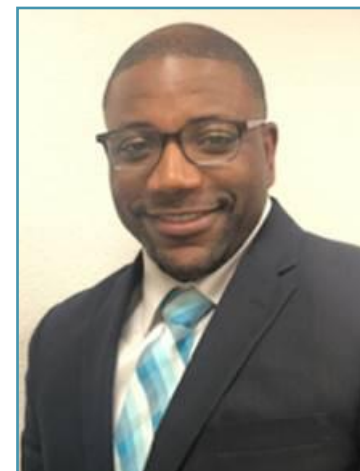

Safety Protocols

2020-2021 Safety Protocol

- Temp checks & safety screening at entry
- Mask required
- Cleaning in the classroom
- Hand sanitizer/washing of hands
- Desk shields
- Social distancing
- Traditional & Remote Learning plan
- School doors open: 7:30 am.

2021-2022 Safety Protocol

- No Temp checks or Safety screening at entry
- Mask strongly recommended
- Cleaning in the classroom
- Hand sanitizer/washing of hands
- Spacing as much as possible
- No remote learning (traditional only)
- Vaccination recommended
- Vaccinated people do not have to quarantine if exposed
- School doors open at 8:00 am.

Bus Routes & Drop Off/Pick Up

- ▶ Bus Routes can be found on the CFB Website.
- ▶ All students need to register for the bus on CFB website.
- ▶ Busses will pick up and drop off in the front circle drive.
(For safety: No cars during this time)



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- ▶ Car riders will drop off/pick up in the back lot by the tennis courts.
 - ▶ Students enter through gym hall doors.
 - ▶ Athletic hallway is not an entry area. Coaches will enter for athletes coming in before 8:00AM

90% Attendance Rule Still Applies

Absence Failure

Having more than 4(four) absences per Block Day = FAILURE

Truancy

Missing more than 10 full or partial days of school in a six month period.

Verified vs. Unverified Absences

There are no EXCUSED absences except with official doctor notices excusing the student. Special circumstances such as funerals should be discussed with the Assistant Principal over the student's attendance. Notes are still required.

The Free and Reduced Meal Online Application is AVAILABLE in August 2021!
For the 2021-2022 school year, all students will be offered FREE MEALS.
Submit an application for 2021-2022 to qualify for free or reduced-price school meals for the beginning of 2022-2023.
SUBMIT AN APPLICATION →
If your household is eligible, the free or reduced meals will begin in 2022-2023 and last until your household qualifies as free or reduced-price again or 30 operating days pass.
Children need healthy meals to learn. Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD offers healthy meals to our students every school day. This school year, Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD offers healthy meals every school day to all students at no cost. Typically, a student's household must meet income eligibility requirements to qualify for free or reduced-price meals. However, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) issued guidance that allows schools to offer meals to all students at no cost for the 2021-2022 school year.
