A Regular Meeting / Study Session of the Board of Education for the Rochester Community Schools, Rochester, Michigan was held on Monday, March 25, 2013, in the Rochester Community Schools Administration Center, 501 West University Drive, Rochester, Michigan. STUDY SESSION

A. The Differentiated Classroom (Informational Item) Ms. Larson and Mrs. Fragomeni

Elementary Program Consultant, Mrs. Scovic opened the evening with a foundation for traditional versus differentiated classroom instruction. She clarified a workshop model for differentiating instructional strategies and focus on professional development for teachers, past, present and future learning opportunities.

The Board started in a fishbowl activity with Ms. April Wuest, Principal of Long Meadow. Ms. Wuest invited board members to "be a fourth grader" and experience a differentiated writing lesson illustrating how targeted instructional strategies can be successfully implemented in a classroom setting.

Board members then moved into small groups where teachers demonstrated how they differentiate in different subject areas using the workshop model.

Ms. Irene Larson, Director of Assessment, gave an overview of a district collaborative initiative to develop a systemic Multi-Tier Approach to teaching and learning.

A panel discussion with questions and answers by Board and audience members was offered to clarify, inquire and grow the conversations around differentiated instruction.


ADJOURNMENT
