

# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

To minimize the spread of germs, we have modified our supply list from previous years to limit the sharing of supplies. Each student will need to bring the following supplies to be prepared for class this year (more of each supply may be needed based on the student's individual use/loss of supplies) Please have your student bring their supplies by the second day of school.:

- 5 Pencils (if mechanical, bring lead)
- 2 Whiteboard markers (Expo Markers-No Red!)
- Manual pencil sharpener with catch basket
- Extra erasers for pencils (pencil toppers or handheld)
- Pencil pouch to hold/organize supplies
- 4 Plastic 2-Pocket Folders (separate colors)
- Glue sticks
- Personal headphones (not USB) to keep at school and container to keep them in
- Duct Tape of your choice to reinforce school cardboard tote (2 large rolls or 3 small rolls, this will cover their totes that they keep in their desks)
- 2 highlighters
- Scissors
- 12 count colored pencils
- Pictures, words, stickers, etc. to decorate Language Arts Composition Notebook, at school, during the first week of school.

The following supplies would be greatly appreciated but **NOT REQUIRED** to help with running our classrooms:

- Tissue boxes
- Ziplock sandwich size bags
- Hand sanitizer
- Clorox/Lysol wipes (We cannot use any other brand for chemical reasons)
- Walmart/Target gift cards for classroom supplies used throughout the year less than \$50
- Magnetic tape
- Money Donation to 6<sup>th</sup> Grade through myDSD
- Any extra supplies from the Student Supply List (pencils, expo markers, black and colored felt tip markers, highlighters, erasers)
