Consent Agenda

A. Approval of 2019 Tax Collection and Distribution Agreement between Charter Twp. of Washington and Rochester Community Schools

Annually, the Board of Education approves an agreement with the Charter Township of Washington to collect school taxes on property located in the Township. This tax collection and distribution agreement is authorized pursuant to MCL 211.43(4) and (12) of the General Property Tax Act and MCL 380.1612 of the Revised School Code. The district agrees to reimburse the Township for its reasonable expenses incurred at a rate of \$1.75 per each parcel for which the Township sends out a tax bill on behalf of the School District. There were no increases to this rate from previous years.

Based on this information, we recommend that the Rochester Board of Education approve the 2019 Tax Collection and Distribution Agreement with the Charter Township of Washington

New Business

A. Construction Project Approval

Recommendation for Award of Contracts and Approval of Current Project Costs for Delta Kelly Elementary Boiler Replacement

Dana Taylor presented the Recommendation for Award of Contracts and Approval of Current Project Costs for Delta Kelly Elementary Boiler Replacement. The recommendation was to award the contract and change order totals of \$93,999 plus \$39,867 for allowances and contract management fees for a net project increase in the amount of \$1,630,882.

Recommendation for Award of Security Window Graphics and Shatterproof Film

Dana Taylor presented the Recommendation for Award of Security Window Graphics and Shatterproof Film. The recommendation was to award the contract total of \$102,223 plus an allowance of \$10,222 for a net project total in the amount of \$112,445.30.

It is important to note that up to \$84,334 will be reimbursed by the 2018 Competitive School Safety Grant Program.
