

# SENIOR CHECKLIST 2021-2022

## AUGUST

- 8/1: TN Promise application window is open – apply for TN Promise through the TSAC portal
- Update your Scoir account (input a personal email address in your profile).
- Update your “Colleges I’m Applying To” list in Scoir.
- Check for college visits in Scoir.
- 8/13: Senior Class Picture (7:45 am - MHS Stadium)
- 8/17: Herff Jones senior meeting (9:45am-10:15am – MHS Gym)
- 8/19: Herff Jones Parent Night (4:00-6:30pm – MHS Gym Lobby)
- 8/24: Senior makeup pictures (MHS Library – Sign up for an appointment in SO1)

## SEPTEMBER

- Begin working on ALL college applications. Pay attention to details and deadlines. Save a copy of all your completed applications.
- Register to take/retake ACT & SAT. Include your social security number on your registration!
- 9/7: TSAC presentations in Senior Transition classes
- 9/29: Blount County College Fair (5:30pm-8:00pm - Maryville College)

## OCTOBER

- 10/1: RECOMMENDED DEADLINE to complete college applications, then update Scoir to have your transcript sent. Your highest ACT scores will appear on your transcript.
- Consult college financial aid offices to check on scholarships, aid information, etc.
- 10/4-10/8: FALL BREAK - Visit colleges!
- 10/19: Senior ACT
- 10/21: TSAC Presentation and FAFSA Workshop at MHS from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m (Ed Harmon Lecture Hall).
- **COMPLETE AND SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA!**

## NOVEMBER

- 11/1: Last chance to complete a UT Promise and TN Promise Application!
- Continue focusing on grades. “Senioritis” may have started!
- Be diligent about checking for scholarships in Scoir.
- **Make sure your FAFSA has been submitted! REMEMBER THAT THE FAFSA allows you to access state aid.**
- Finish strong. Do well on your semester exams!
- Check your Student Aid Report (SAR) that you should have received after you completed the FAFSA.

## JANUARY

- Begin spring term with purpose. Final grades DO matter to colleges, and acceptance to college is contingent on final (end of year) transcript.
- Continue completing scholarship applications.
- Request your mid-year Common App transcript.

## FEBRUARY

- 2/1: FAFSA filing DEADLINE
- Stay on top of grades and scholarship applications.

## MARCH

- Prepare for your **LAST** high school semester exams!
- 3/14-3/18: SPRING BREAK!
- The scholarship list updates frequently. Keep checking!
- Plan to view the required TN Promise webinar (window: March – May).

## APRIL

- 4/15: Graduating with Distinction Applications are due (see the website).
- 4/22: Prom and Senior Seminars
- 4/29: DEADLINE to review your college acceptances and financial aid awards. Make your selection!
- Prepare for any upcoming AP exams.

## MAY

- Complete all necessary senior tasks – final transcript, etc.
- Attend ALL graduation activities!
- 5/6, 5/9: Senior exams
- 5/9-5/13: Senior events (5/10: Last day; 5/11: Senior Banquet, 5/12: Graduation practice and Baccalaureate)
- 5/13: GRADUATION! (5/13: 8am Graduation practice)
