
Accompanying this letter is important information regarding the first few weeks of the new school year. As always, if you have any questions, comments, or concerns, please feel free to contact us at any time.

Daily Arrival

- Students may arrive at XMS after 7 AM and will report to the gym/cafeteria. The school doors will remain locked until 7 AM
- Students arriving between 7 AM & 7:30 AM should enter through door #4.
- Students arriving to school between 7:30 AM & 8 AM should use door #4 or door #7
- Students will be dismissed from the gym/cafeteria at 7:45 AM to their lockers to begin school at 8 AM
- There is no additional charge or registration

Daily Schedule

- School begins at 8 AM and ends at 3:30 PM
- Students are required to be in their homeroom by 8 AM, which means students should arrive no later than 7:55 AM to have enough time to get to their homeroom

School Photo Day

- Friday, Aug 27th
- Individual student photos will be taken in the morning
- Students are encouraged to dress up, but at minimum be in school uniform
- Please bring in payment along with the photo packet for additional school photos on this day

XMS Parent Night

- Wednesday, Sept 8th from 6:30 PM 8 PM
- Parents will be able to meet staff and learn about academic, spiritual, and co-curricular programs offered at XMS
- Students do not need to attend as the night is geared towards the parents

One-For-All Initiative

- Each student will have access to their own chromebook device throughout the school day
- The students will collect their chromebook from their homeroom teacher to begin the school day and will return their chromebook to their homeroom teacher at the end of the school day

Backpacks

- Only 7th & 8th grade students will be allowed to carry backpacks from class to class
- 5th & 6th grade students will keep their backpacks in their lockers during the school day
- Parents are asked to work with their 7th and/or 8th grade child to keep their backpack clean and organized throughout the school year
