Wausau, nestled in the valley of the Wisconsin River, is a hub of north central Wisconsin in terms of shopping, education, and employment. The surrounding area is primarily rural with industry centered around manufacturing and health care. The metropolitan area population is approximately 40,000. Wausau supports a two-year university center, a technical college, and a regional site for the Medical College of Wisconsin. Additionally, recreation abounds with the historic 400 block, the Leigh Yawkey Woodson Art Museum, The Grand Theater, Rib Mountain State Park, and Granite Peak Ski area.
