FUHSD COVID-19 Response Plan - Scenario 2 - Student is a Close Contact

A student lives in a household with or has had close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.

A Close Contact is defined as someone who was within 6 feet of the infected person for at least 15 minutes at any time beginning 2 days before the infected person had symptoms or tested positive.

Student

- If you have had COVID-19 within 90 days of becoming a close contact, you do not need to quarantine but, continue to monitor your symptoms.
- If you are at school and receive information that you are a close contact to a positive case outside of school, ensure you are wearing your mask and notify the adult where you are located in order to arrange to go home.
- If you are at home and you learn that you are a close contact to a positive case, do not go to school. Contact the COVID-19 Designee for your school site.
 - If a positive case occurs at school in which you become a close contact, the Site COVID-19 Designee will contact you and provide direction. Follow Close Contact Quarantine Guidelines, below.
 - 1. Monitor health and contact doctor if symptoms appear.
 - 2. Get a COVID-19 test: (a) Immediately if symptomatic or (b) in 6 days after exposure if not symptomatic.
 - Whether experiencing symptoms or not, it is important to follow the <u>Home Isolation & Quarantine Guidelines</u> while awaiting tests results.
 - 3. Contact Site COVID-19 Designee when test results are received.
 - If positive, follow <u>Home Isolation & Quarantine Guidelines</u>.
 - If negative and earlier than 6 days after last exposure, get tested again at or after 6 days.
 - If negative after 6 days from last exposure, no additional testing is needed. Quarantine may end after 10 days, if not experiencing symptoms. Continue to monitor for COVID19 symptoms.
 - 4. Contact Site COVID-19 Designee to discuss return to school plan. (May return to school no sooner than the 10-day quarantine and 24 hours after symptom improvement.)

Site COVID-19 Designee

- 1. If student is at school, immediately arrange for their pick-up or release from school.
- 2. Provide quarantine instructions to student.
- 3. Instruct student to get tested: (a) Immediately if symptomatic or (b) in 6 days after exposure if not symptomatic.
 - Request immediate contact from student when test results are available.
- 4. Immediately notify the District COVID-19 Designee via phone and email by sharing the student questionnaire Google doc.
- 5. Provide student(s) with close contact email follow-up.
- 6. Contact the Facilities Manager to ensure disinfecting process is followed and Facilities Department has been notified.
- 7. Ensure student stays home for appropriate quarantine period (see guidelines below).
- 8. Track test results.
- 9. Discuss test results with student when received:
 - If test is positive: Provide isolation advice to student (10 days), Initiate Close Contact Tracking Questionnaire, Contact HR and District COVID-19 Designee, and send required forms and letters for communication.
 - If test is negative and not experiencing symptoms, per guidelines below, quarantine can end on day 7.
- 10. Discuss return to school with student and confirm with District COVID-19 Designee.

Facilities Manager

- 1. Facilities Manager immediately notifies Facilities Department of possible exposure.
- 2. Facilities Department confirms required disinfecting protocols with Facilities Manager and Site COVID-19 Designee.

District COVID-19 Designee: Trudy Gross, Associate Superintendent

- 1. Confirm with the Site COVID-19 Designee that instructions have been provided for quarantine, until test results are known.
- 2. Confirm required disinfecting protocols with Facilities Department.
- 3. Provide Site COVID-19 Designee with forms and letters for communication.

Close Contact Quarantine Guidelines

For fully vaccinated individuals:

• Fully vaccinated and asymptomatic students do not need to quarantine and can remain on campus.

For unvaccinated individuals:

- If symptomatic, the student must quarantine for 10 days and be tested for COVID-19.
- If asymptomatic AND both the COVID-positive and person exposed (close contact) were wearing masks: student may remain on campus AND must tested for COVID-19 twice per week for 10 days post-exposure. Student CANNOT participate in athletics or extracurricular activities for 10 days post-exposure.
- If asymptomatic AND both the COVID-positive and person exposed (close contact) were NOT wearing masks: student will need to quarantine for 10 days if choosing to not be tested for COVID-19. Quarantine may shorten to 7 days if student receives a negative test result 6 days post-exposure.

For symptomatic individuals (fully vaccinated or not):

• Must quarantine for the full 10 days and be tested for COVID-19.
