- (3) Please review the **suggested supply list**. Additional supplies will be shared by teachers.

 - (4) Please review the **technology** and “Core 4” information on the [Delta Prep page](#) of our website, which includes information on technology help for student laptops.
 - (5) ****IMPORTANT—PLEASE READ ALL INFO HERE**** All students will be eligible for free meals this year across Washington State. However, we still need families to complete the free/reduced-price lunch application if you may qualify. *Qualifying students may also be eligible for other benefits, including free or reduced costs for college applications, free enrollment in College in the High School courses at Delta, and more.* Applications may be completed online or on paper. Any Delta student may apply for free/reduced-price meals through Pasco School District, or you may also apply through your home district.  - (6) **Daily Class Schedule:** At this time we expect to be using a schedule similar to the end of the 2020-2021 school year with two lunches built in to support distancing while students are eating and unmasked. Daily schedules can be found on our website on the [Daily Class Schedules & Attendance](#) page. We are still developing the schedule for our first week, but for now note that all 9th grade students will attend their first day on Tuesday, 8/31, while the rest of our students will start on Wednesday, 9/1.



- (7) **Health & Safety:** At this time, all students and staff will be required to wear masks while indoors at Delta High School. Three-foot distancing will be the norm in classrooms, with six-foot distancing in the cafeteria during lunches. We appreciate the support of our students and families as we comply with current regulations and show care for our community by prioritizing health and safety.
- (8) **Remind:** Are you signed up yet for Remind? **All students and parents should sign up for Remind** as it is our main method of communication for the school community.
