

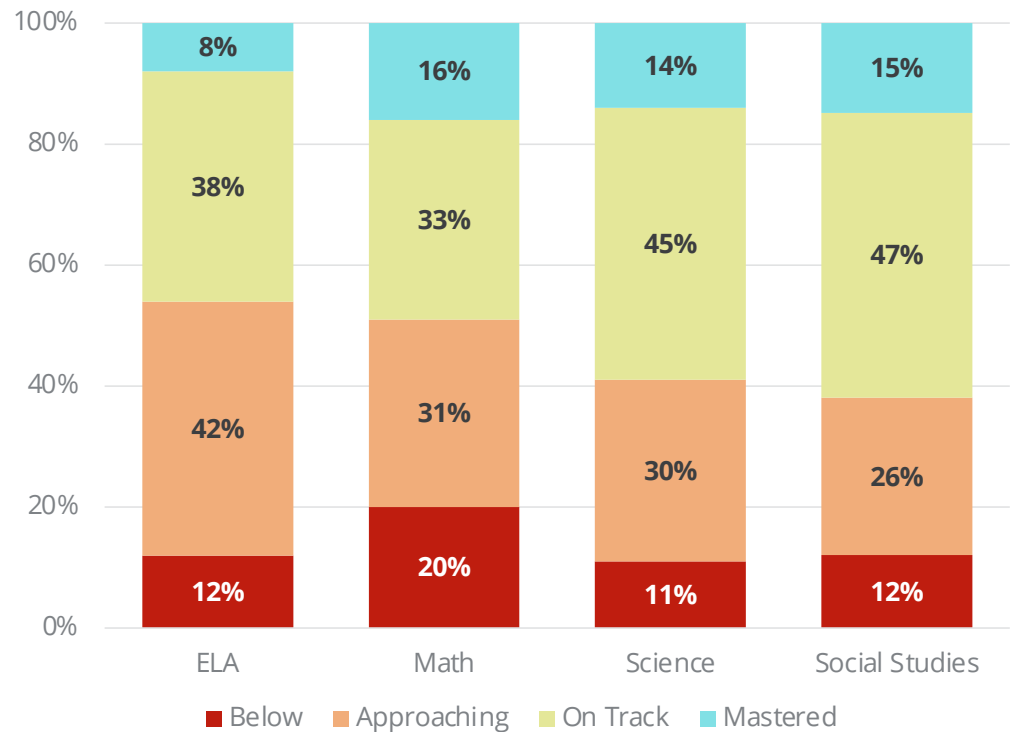


SUBJECT AREA PROFICIENCY

OVERVIEW: ALL STUDENTS, GRADES & SUBJECTS IN FSSD

KEY TAKE-AWAYS

- The FSSD continues to outperform the state averages in all subject areas on 2021 TCAP proficiency percentages:
 - ELA = 14% higher proficiency;
 - Math = 16% higher proficiency;
 - Science = 27% higher proficiency;
 - Social Studies = 29% higher proficiency
- As expected, the ELA and Math proficiency percentages for “Mastered” and “On Track” followed the state trend, decreasing by 4% and 12% respectively when compared to the 2019 TCAP results.
- Many strategies are actively in place in FSSD to increase students’ proficiency in key areas such as early literacy and basic math skills.
- FSSD ranked **first** in the state in Geometry, a high school subject offered to accelerated learners in FSSD middle schools.

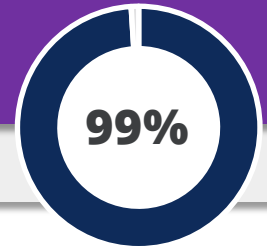




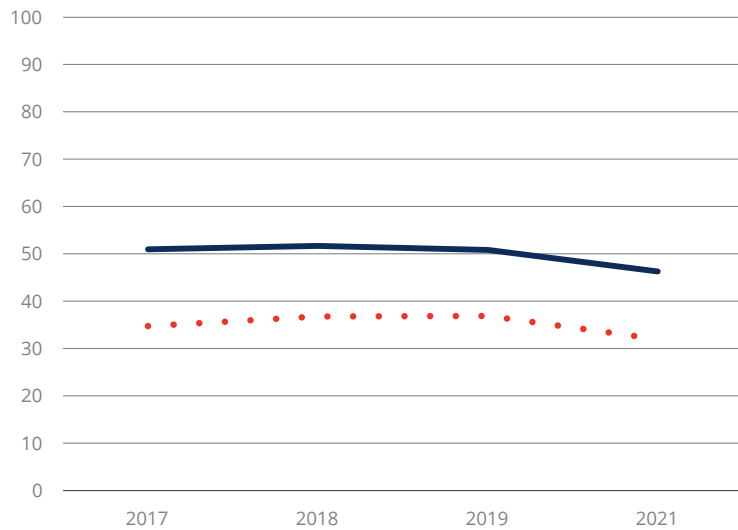

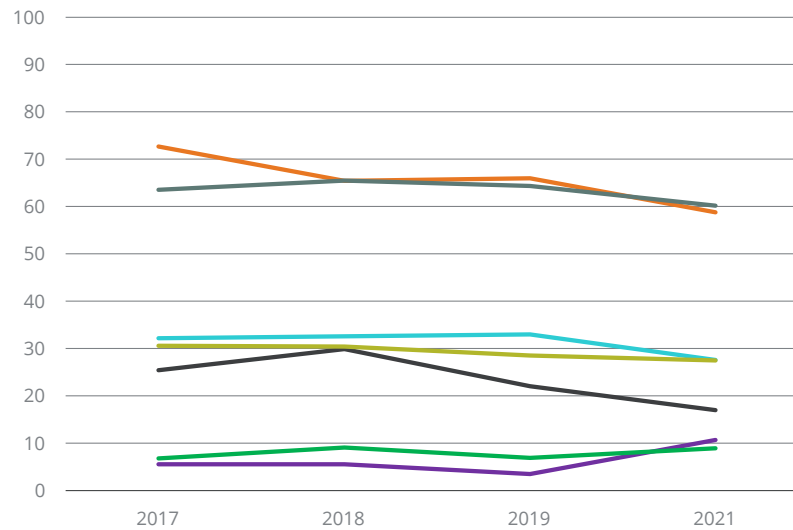
2021 TCAP District Participation Rate

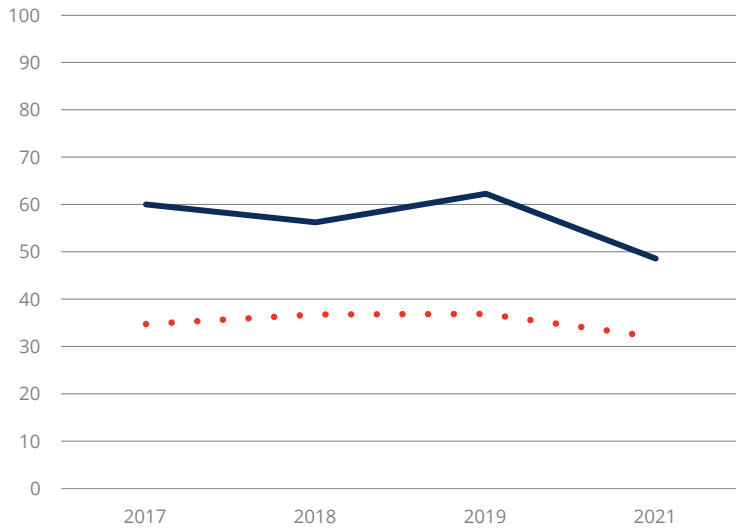

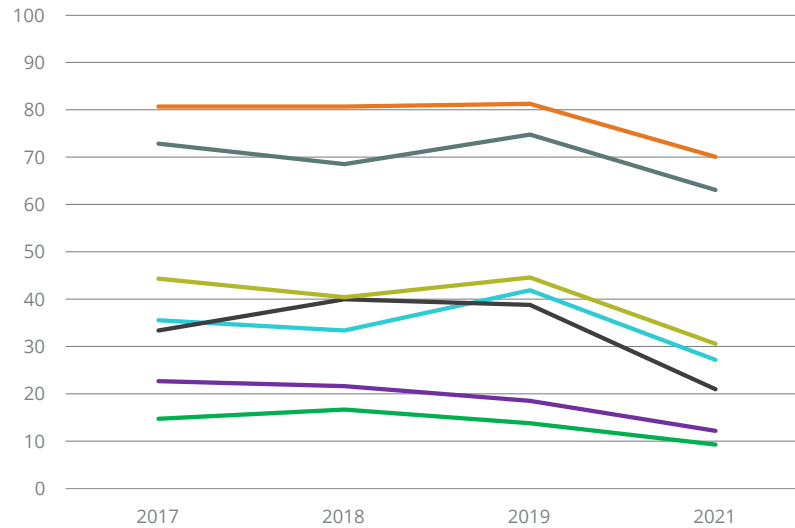
2021 TCAP District Participation Rate

*No subgroups in FSSD increased their math proficiency percentage from 2019 to 2021.

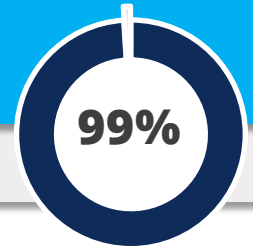
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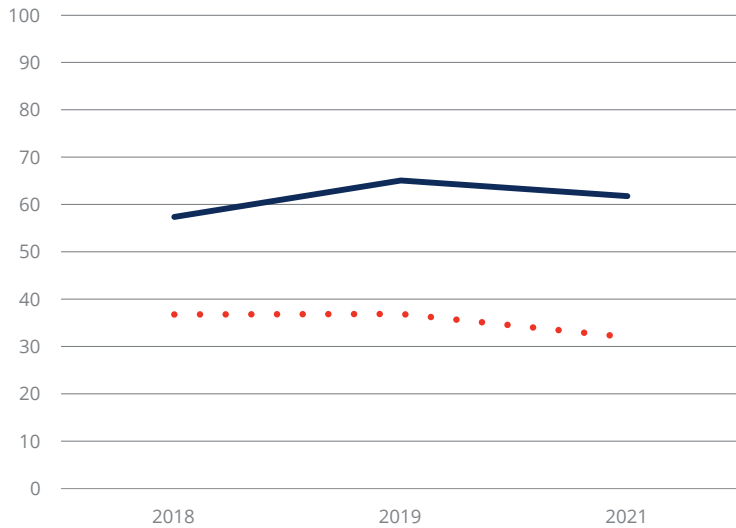

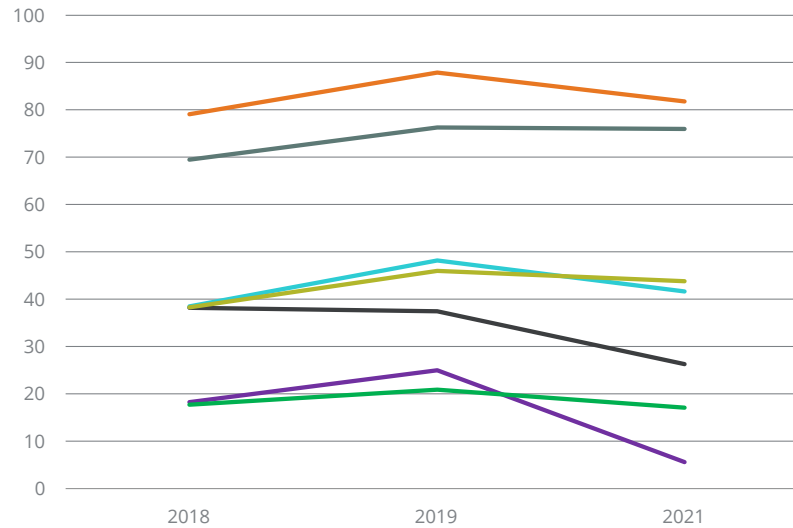
2021 TCAP District Participation Rate
