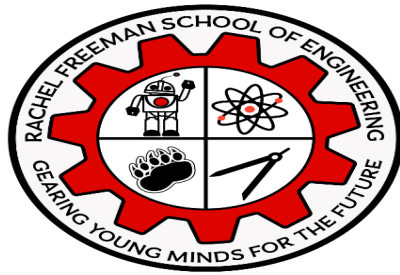

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of the Read to Achieve law (G.S. §115C-83.1) passed by the General Assembly in 2012, your child will take the Beginning-of-Grade 3 (BOG3) Reading Test to establish a baseline measure of beginning third-grade reading skills. This test will be administered online on August, 24th, 2021. The majority of beginning third-grade students are not expected to demonstrate third-grade reading proficiency (score an achievement level 3, 4, or 5) on the BOG3 Test because they have received very little third-grade reading instruction. Following the BOG3 Test administration, you will receive an individual student report with your child's score. At the end of the school year, your child will take the End of Grade 3 Reading Test (EOG) to measure growth from the BOG3.
