

**McCALLIE SCHOOL RULES GOVERNING TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS TO AND FROM
SCHOOL, HOME AND SCHOOL EVENTS**

FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS

Bus transportation shall be conditioned on good behavior and observance of the following rules. Drivers are authorized to enforce these rules and students who violate them will be subject to disciplinary action. Violations will be reported to the Dean of Students, who may refer such to the Discipline Committee. Continued violations may result in bus suspension for a period of time.

1. Be on time at the designated bus stop. Help keep the bus on schedule as it will not wait for late arriving passengers. Parents, once the bus leaves the parking lot the driver will NOT stop the bus for late arrivals-do NOT attempt to pull the bus over.
2. Before entering the bus, your face masks MUST be on and to remain on at all time.
3. Passengers must sanitize hands upon entering bus (sanitizer provided)
4. Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before attempting to enter or leave the bus.
5. Keep all parts of your body and all objects inside the bus.
6. Stay in your seat and do not attempt to move about while the bus is in motion.
7. Loud talking or yelling is prohibited as this could distract the driver and cause a serious accident. Classroom conduct should be observed.
8. Profane or immoral language, improper conduct, and use of tobacco are prohibited on the bus.
9. Keep the aisle clear and use only when entering or exiting the bus.
10. Throwing objects is prohibited
11. Eating or drink on bus is prohibited
12. Do not damage or tamper with bus equipment. Individual will be responsible for damages and will be made to pay for the cost of repairs.
13. The driver is in full charge of the bus and passengers. Students must obey the driver at all time.
14. Students must not cross the road in the back of the bus, always cross in front.
15. In case of road emergency, remain in the bus until instructions are given by the driver or other authorities.
16. You must be quiet when approaching or crossing railroad tracks.
17. Put all cell phones on vibrate or silent so ringing of phones won't distract the driver.

If needed bus drive will assign seats.

Please be courteous to fellow students and the driver. Help us keep a safe transportation program by your cooperation and GOOD BEHAVIOR.
