



### **Covid-19 Protocols**

**Student Check in Procedures:** 

- **Pre-screening questions** of symptoms should be done at home before coming to campus.
- Weekly COVID-19 testing (In order to opt out you must provide the original copy of immunization card-front office will make a copy)
- Masks will be required indoors at all times

## **Attendance (Absence Procedures)**

- Parents/Guardians must call the attendance office between 7:30 am and 8:30 am <u>each day</u> the student is absent.
- **Upon returning to school** after an absence, the student must bring a note from parent or a doctor's note to the Attendance office.

## **Attendance (Absence Note Content)**

- Student's name and grade
- Date(s) of absence
- The explicit reason for absence
- The signature of the parent/guardian and the phone number(s) at which parent/guardian may be contacted during the school day.
- Upon receiving the note, the attendance office will then excuse the absence, otherwise it will remain unexcused.

### Types of Absences (Excused vs. Unexcused)

#### **Excused Absences**

- Illness\*
- Medical/Dental appointments\*
- Funerals
- Quarantine
- Court appearances\*
- Approved school activities (ie. retreats, sporting events, school sponsored field trips)

\*Must provide official doctor/court documentation

#### **Unexcused Absences**

- No doctor's/court note upon return to school
- Vacation
- Outside organization sports teams

### **Student Checkout Process (Main Office)**

#### Step 1 Notify Main Office

- Parent note submitted before first class of the day
  - Student released when indicated on note
- Parent phone call to main office
  - Student will be called down upon parent arrival

#### Step 2: Sign Out Student

- PMA will release student to Parent/Guardian or any of the 3 emergency contacts
- All parents/guardians and emergency contacts MUST provide a photo ID to check out students





## Google Classroom: Guardian Summaries

As a guardian, you can get email summaries about your student's activity in Classroom. Email summaries do not include grades. For grades check Powerschool.

In email summaries, you can review:

- **Missing work**—Work not turned in when the summary was sent.
- **Upcoming work**—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails).
- **Class activities**—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers.



# Google Classroom: Get Guardian Summaries


To get email summaries of your student's work, you must accept an email invitation from a teacher or administrator. You have 120 days to accept an invitation before it expires. You can unsubscribe from summaries or remove yourself as a guardian at any time.

- 1. The teacher or administrator emails you an invitation to join your student's class.
- 2. In your email program, open your email invitation.
- 3. Click Accept.

If you're not the guardian, click I'm Not The Guardian.

4. Click **Accept** to confirm.

When you accept an invitation, you and your student get an email confirmation.
