We are so excited to have the opportunity to meet in library again for activity this year with safety precautions in place. Students are assigned seats next to friends they sit near in class safely distanced. We are reviewing and modeling BEST expectations for library this month to ensure all of our friends know how to have a successful, safe, and FUN time in library!

PreK-2nd Grades: During the month of August and September, we will review library and school rules and procedures and read entertaining texts to help us learn. Some of these texts include Manners in Library, We Don't Eat Our Classmates, We Will Rock Our Classmates, and Time for School, Little Blue Truck. We are striving to go deep in our read alouds through open discussions where we make predictions, build background knowledge, analyze vocabulary, make connections, and ask important questions as readers. After read aloud time, students will participate in literacy centers with proper sanitation immediately following.

3rd-6th Grades: We are delving in deep to Mrs. Therrell's Library Google Classroom. Students are learning all kinds of resources they can find here like our Destiny-Book Catalog, Ebook selections, activities, and projects. There are also useful tools to help our students prepare for an optional, but highly encouraged yearlong project they may work on called Deweyland in which they will strive to read and prove their comprehension on a variety of books in our Dewey Decimal System throughout the year. Mini-lessons will be taught throughout August and September on the Dewey Decimal System and library organization and management.
