Test Name	Grade	Date	Purpose
WIDA Screener	K-7	1 st 45 days of school	The WIDA-ACCESS Placement Test (W-APT™) is the assessment used in North Carolina for initial identification and placement of students identified as limited English proficient. Eligibility assessment on the W-APT is based on results of the Home Language Survey (HLS) process. The HLS process, identification, and subsequent placement of limited English proficient students in English as a Second Language (ESL) services are guided at the state level by the NCDPI Curriculum and Instruction Division.
BOG3	3	Between 11th-15th day of school September 8-14	As part of the Read to Achieve legislation (G.S. 115C-83.1A) passed by the General Assembly in 2012, your child will be given a beginning-of-grade standardized test to establish a baseline measure of how he or she is reading.
NWEA-MAP	K-7	<i>Fall (BOY)</i> August 30-September 10 <i>Winter (MOY)</i> February 7-17 <i>Spring (EOY)</i> April 19-22 (Grades 3-8) May 9-13 (Grades K-2)	NWEA-MAP is a computer adaptive test that students take three times a year. The results provide teachers with information to help them deliver appropriate content for each student and determine each student's academic growth over time. *Fall 2020-ALL 4 th Grade students are required to take a BOY SBE approved Literacy assessment. BCCA will administer the NWEA MAP assessment for 4th grade students within the first ten days for this purpose.
WIDA ACCESS	K-7	February-March	Results from the ACCESS Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking tests for English Language Learners (ELLs) are used to determine whether a student has exited Limited English Proficiency (LEP) identification. This is administered online.
Reading EOG	3-7	Final 10 days of school May 25, 2022	The North Carolina End-of-Grade Tests are designed to measure student performance on the goals, objectives, and grade-level competencies specified in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study.
Math EOG	3-7	Final 10 days of school May 26, 2022	The North Carolina End-of-Grade Tests are designed to measure student performance on the goals, objectives, and grade-level competencies specified in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study.
Science EOG	5 & 8	Final 10 days of school May 31, 2022	The North Carolina End-of-Grade Tests are designed to measure student performance on the goals, objectives, and grade-level competencies specified in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study.
Read to Achieve	3	May 31, 2022	Students in grade 3 who do not show proficiency on the Grade 3 Reading EOG will be administered the Read to Achieve test.
