## EDMENTUM Program

Credit Recovery Registration Guide

### What is EDMENTUM?

EDMENTUM is a standards-based online learning program. EDMENTUM provides courses in a wide range of core subjects and electives. Courses consist of integrated assessments, including exempted pretests that allow learners to skip content they have already mastered and focus on the concepts that need additional improvement. Course-level assessments also include tests for each course module to ensure concept mastery.

### Why EDMENTUM?

EDMENTUM allows students to recover credits, while managing their normal school work.

### When & Where?

EDMENTUM can be completed on any internet capable device, allowing students to work at home, in study halls, etc. Work at your own pace, and retake failed quizzes and proctored tests until they obtain a satisfactory score.

### EDMENTUM Policies

Once registered, students:

- Take 1 PLATO course at a time, even with future courses added.
- Earn up to 7 credits online through EDMENTUM over your high school career.
- Students will report to ASCs & counselors for credit counts (completed EDMENTUM credit inquiries).
- Must complete classes within one year of signing up.
- Must score 60% or higher on quizzes to advance to finals/post tests.
- Must average 60% or higher on all Post Tests (final exams).  
Students will NOT receive course credit without meeting this standard.
- ALL Unit Post Tests and will be checked, and final exams proctored before credit is given and before moving onto the next course.
