

# STUDENT PROCESS MAP FOR COVID-19

These actions will always be performed with care and concern for the child with all attempts to minimize anxiety or fear.

SITUATION	Student is confirmed to have COVID-19 with or without symptoms. (home tests not accepted)	Student has fever of 100°F OR <u>two</u> or more symptoms BEFORE entry to building	Student reports experiencing <u>two</u> or more symptoms of COVID-19 during the school day	Student is quarantined due to direct contact with someone who is confirmed with COVID-19	Vaccinated student reports having direct contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case (Includes those within their home).
ACTION	The student does not report to school or participate in other school activities.	The student does not report to school or participate in other school activities.	Student is isolated. Parents are called to pick up student as quickly as possible	The student does not report to school or participate in other school activities. Students will remain home to monitor for symptoms for up to 10 days. However, additional options are provided in the RETURN column below.	-Student does not need to quarantine and may report to school if not symptomatic. -Self monitor for symptoms and get tested if any COVID signs develop. -Wearing a mask indoors for 14 days is recommended.
COMMUNICATION	Upon notification of a confirmed COVID-19 case on a campus, the principal or district representative will communicate with teachers, staff, and families of students who were potentially exposed.	Parent notifies campus attendance clerk.  Classroom teacher is notified by attendance clerk.	Classroom teacher is notified by nurse.	Parent notifies campus principal and/or nurse  Classroom teachers are notified by attendance clerk	Parents should report the exposure to their campus nurse.

RETURN	-Isolate for 10 days from onset of symptoms, at least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications, and the individual has improvement of symptoms.	-Obtain documentation from a doctor clearing the individual for return based on an alternative diagnosis  <b>OR</b> -Obtains a negative COVID-19 test result with proper documentation.  <b>OR</b> - Symptom free for 24 hours or more without the use of fever-reducing medication.	-Obtain documentation from a doctor clearing the individual for return based on an alternative diagnosis  <b>OR</b> -Obtains a negative COVID-19 test result with proper documentation.  <b>OR</b> -Symptom free for 24 hours or more without the use of fever-reducing medication.	<b>OPTION 1-After day 7 without symptoms</b> -Obtain a negative COVID-19 test result with proper documentation (Test not to be performed prior to day 5) -Mask recommended and self-monitor through day 10.  <b>OR</b> <b>OPTION 2-After day 10 without symptoms</b> -Mask recommended and self-monitor through day 14.	Symptom free student may report to school as usual.
