BILINGUAL PROGRAM/DUAL LANGUAGE

Our Bilingual Program (PK4-4th) develops bilingual and biliterate students in English and Spanish. Oppe offers a Dual Language Two-Way Immersion model in which both native English and native speakers of another language (Spanish) receive instruction together in both languages. This model will grow each year by one grade level. These programs give students the much sought-after language skills that provide an advantage in our multicultural world.

Greta's Garden, students are immersed in learning about nature. When students, staff, families and community grow vegetables in our outdoor classroom, they develop life skills, increase environmental awareness, and make the connection between growing food and healthy diets.

- Participating in project and problem-based learning experiences to promote critical thinking
- Maintaining an on-site oyster and red drum aquatic habitat
- Planting and maintaining native coastal prairie grasses for spring replanting event
- Cultivating and monitoring an on-site mini-marsh habitat
- Growing, maintaining, and harvesting edible plants in Greta's Garden
