*We will only charge a fee for an unsuccessful appeal by independent schools to cover our costs. The DfE has provided funding that covers the fixed costs of exam boards for appeals made by state schools and colleges and those appealing on behalf of private candidates, but not independent candidates. We are charging a fee which is equivalent to the funding we are receiving for state school students.
