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# Curriculum Updates

**Addressing Anxiety**: Consistent with our focus on social and emotional learning, we are leveraging our federal funds this fall to assist our families by offering a live, interactive webinar with <u>Lynn Lyons</u>, an expert on the topic of anxiety. She will be providing strategies for our students



(and ourselves) to help manage the anxiety that comes with the many uncertainties of our current environment. Please save the date and time of November 4 from 6:00pm - 7:30pm for the parent and community event titled, "*NOW What? Helping Children (and Parents) Manage Emotionally During Uncertain Times*." More information will be provided in the coming weeks. Our staff will also have an opportunity to learn from Lynn via live webinars scheduled through the fall.

**i-Ready Information for grades K-9**: As we move into October, we will be continuing to use our i-Ready suite of tools. This online assessment provides teachers with diagnostic information. The results assist teachers in identifying what the instructional next steps are for a student along with information they gather from student's work. The results also set the appropriate level of challenge in the Personalized Instruction (My Path) tool for your child. *This diagnostic assessment is not an achievement test from which any placement decisions are made.* We have scheduled the fall session for Oct.13th through the 30th. We are looking into how our students might be able to take this assessment at home rather than in school. More information will be provided either within this newsletter or via your child's school and teacher.

# Health & Safety

We have good news regarding the out of state travel guidelines for students returning to school. Massachusetts has been added to the exemption list! Please refer to the guidelines below and remember that out of state travel is a key question on our pre-screening tool for school attendance. As always, please contact your school nurse with any questions.

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL

- Students who are Maine residents traveling to non-exempt states\* for any reason, including, but not limited to, medical or behavioral health visits, educational purposes, or custody or visitation with parents, are required to either quarantine for 14 days OR obtain a negative COVID test upon returning to Maine and prior to returning to school or any school activities.
- 2. A copy of the student's COVID test results must be provided to Health Services Staff prior to returning to school or school related activities.

\*At this time, the Governor's "Stay Safer at Home" order exempts the following states: Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont, Connecticut, New York, and New Jersey
