"If I am not for myself, who will be for me? If I am only for myself, what am I? If not now, when?" (Rabbi Hillel, *Pirkei Avot*). These questions are not independent from one another; rather, they are inseparable. We must be constantly mindful in these complicated times that we are equally responsible for protecting both our own and others' health and safety.

Each family in the community as well as every member of Barrack's faculty and staff must sign this Kehillah/Community Commitment to affirm that our mutual sense of responsibility is our highest priority. Our families and staff agree to be guided by our four Derech Eretz values — Honor, Courage, Kindness, and Community — and to comply with each of the following terms:

- Get a flu shot or submit a medical exemption from a physician by October 15th, 2021.
- Wear a mask in all mask-designated areas while on campus and adhere to three-foot distancing.
- Stay home when not feeling well or when exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms.
- Complete the RUVNA checklist every morning before school in order to be on campus.
- Contact the school immediately should a member of the family contract COVID-19 or be exposed to COVID-19.
- Follow federal, state, local, and institutional guidelines to help reduce the transmission of COVID-19.
- Adhere to CDC guidelines for quarantine/testing before safely returning to campus after any domestic or international travel.
- Be mindful of participation in social gatherings or attending events off campus that may cause risk to the greater community.
- Understand and accept that socialization will look different at school.
- Understand that Barrack will have protocols in place for all school visitors, including parents.
- Uphold communal standards and expectations for health and safety both in and out of school.

Failure to comply with these terms may result in dismissal from campus and further disciplinary actions.
