

## **ECPPS Expectations for Virtual**

### **Student Expectations:**

- Students are expected to attend all scheduled virtual meetings and complete all assignments by the communicated deadline.
- Students are expected to work consistently online; five days a week and complete the course by the posted end date of the term.
- Students are expected to advocate for themselves with their teacher(s).
- Students are expected to review all graded assignments that have been returned and be available to converse with the teacher.
- Students are expected to be honest and do their own work.
- Students are expected to come in person for all state and local assessments on the assigned day and time.
- Students are expected to show their parents their grades and give them user access to the course.

### **Parent Expectations:**

- Parents are expected to have their child attend virtual instruction daily.
- Parents are expected to encourage their children to stay on pace and to submit all work by the communicated deadline.
- Parents are expected to let their children advocate with the instructor.
- Parents are expected to ensure their child does their own work.
- Parents are expected to review, with their child, their child's progress/grades.

### **Staff Expectations:**

- Staff is expected to have regular, documented, and ongoing instructive interaction with the student.
- Staff is expected to answer emails within 24 hours Monday-Friday, excluding holidays and weekends.
- Staff is expected to grade assignments with instructive comments/feedback and return to the student within one week. The exception is the last two weeks of the course. Assignments turned in during the final two weeks of the 9 weeks are not expected to be returned until after the 9 week grading period.
- Staff is expected to update PowerSchool (weekly for all classes and communicate progress from Edgenuity classes).
- Staff is expected to keep daily attendance in PowerSchool.
- Staff is expected to inform students and parents when the student is two weeks or more behind pace.
- Staff is expected to communicate the schedule, provide meeting links, and post weekly assignments on Monday to Canvas.
- Staff will show their faces in all virtual classes and meetings.
