

Emotional Support

Emotional Support programs are for students whose behavior interferes with their ability to learn and progress within the general curriculum in the regular education setting. Students may participate in this program in varying degrees of inclusion into the regular education classroom depending upon their behavioral competencies. Itinerant, supplemental and full-time support is available to students from K-12 in conjunction with other support programs in all district buildings; intensive services for students in need of a greater degree of support is provided in Grandview Elementary, Westlake Middle School, McDowell Intermediate High School, and McDowell High School. MTSD also provides the educational component for students in the Sarah A. Reed Children's Center (SARCC) residential treatment facility located within district boundaries.
