# Current State of COVID

## Governor Requirements

GA-36: School Systems cannot require students or staff to wear a mask.

## Texas Education Agency Requirement

Allowance for remote conferencing

Schools are not required to contact trace

Parent option of keeping student at home or sending to school if in close contact

## Area School District & County Actions

Dallas ISD and Fort Worth ISD Face Masks Mandates

Judge Jenkins Mandate

## Protective Equipment & Practices

- Face coverings recommended
- Routine temperature checks
- Social distancing of 3 ft.
- Isolation room
- Assemblies and visitors allowed with social distancing



## Cleaning & Sanitation Protocols

- Nightly e-misting of facilities
- Handheld e-misters in classrooms
- Routine hand sanitizing & washing
- Disinfecting of materials and technology
- Daily school bus cleaning & available hand sanitizer





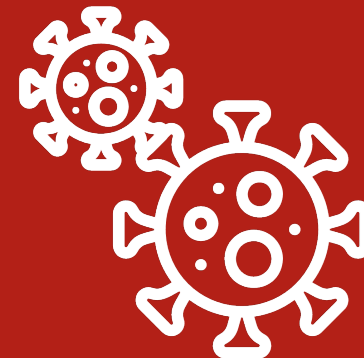
## Monitoring Symptoms & Exposure

- Daily screener is not required
- Nurses will monitor symptoms
- Unvaccinated, symptomatic students will quarantine a minimum of 7 days
- Return with a negative COVID test after day 5 or doctor's diagnosis and no fever



## Responding to COVID-19 Cases

- Positive students or staff will submit a notification
- Campus will contact trace
- Additional campus sanitation



## Parent & Staff Notifications

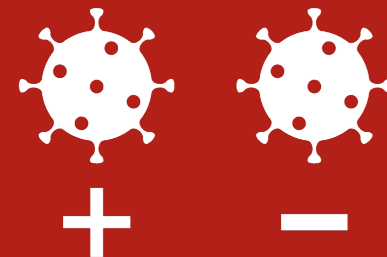
- Individual students and staff will be notified if exposed to an on campus case of COVID-19.
- A general notification will be sent to all staff and students if there is a positive student COVID-19 case.



## Rapid Testing for Staff

Rapid testing for COVID-19 will be available for all staff members through the campus clinics during defined hours.

Appointments will be required.

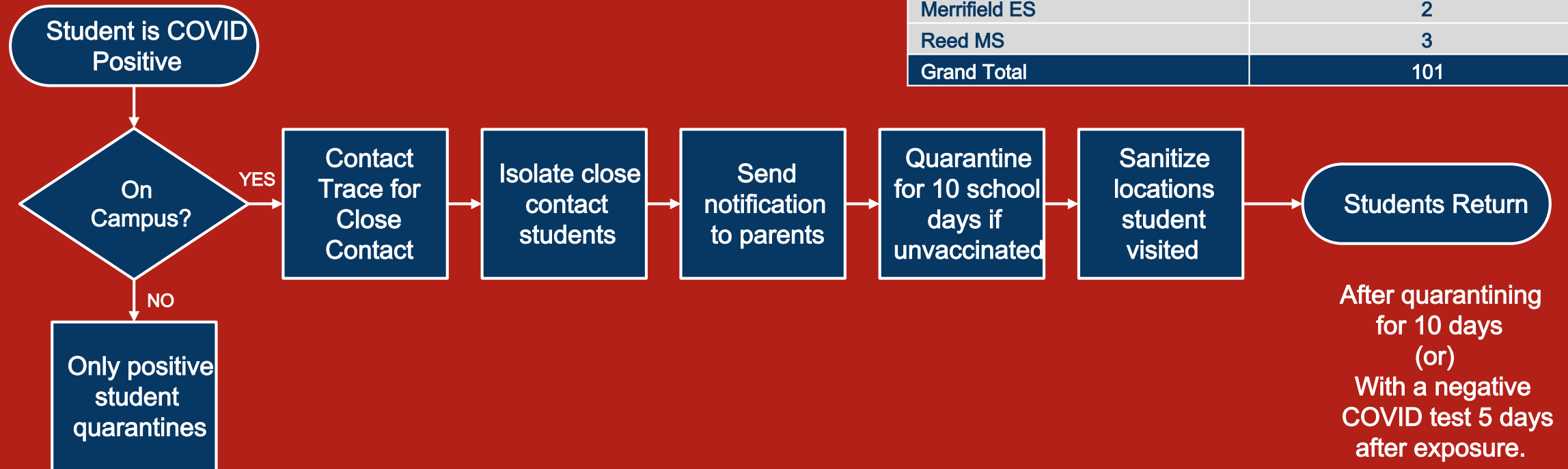

# STAFF COVID-19 UPDATE

## Personal Leave

- The Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) expired December 31, 2020
- The District extended District Paid Sick Leave to all staff until June 30, 2021 for COVID-19
- Currently the District does not offer paid sick leave for COVID-19. Employees are able to use any leave they have available to quarantine as with any other illness
- Family Medical Leave and the Sick Leave Bank are options staff have for job protection and access to additional days if needed

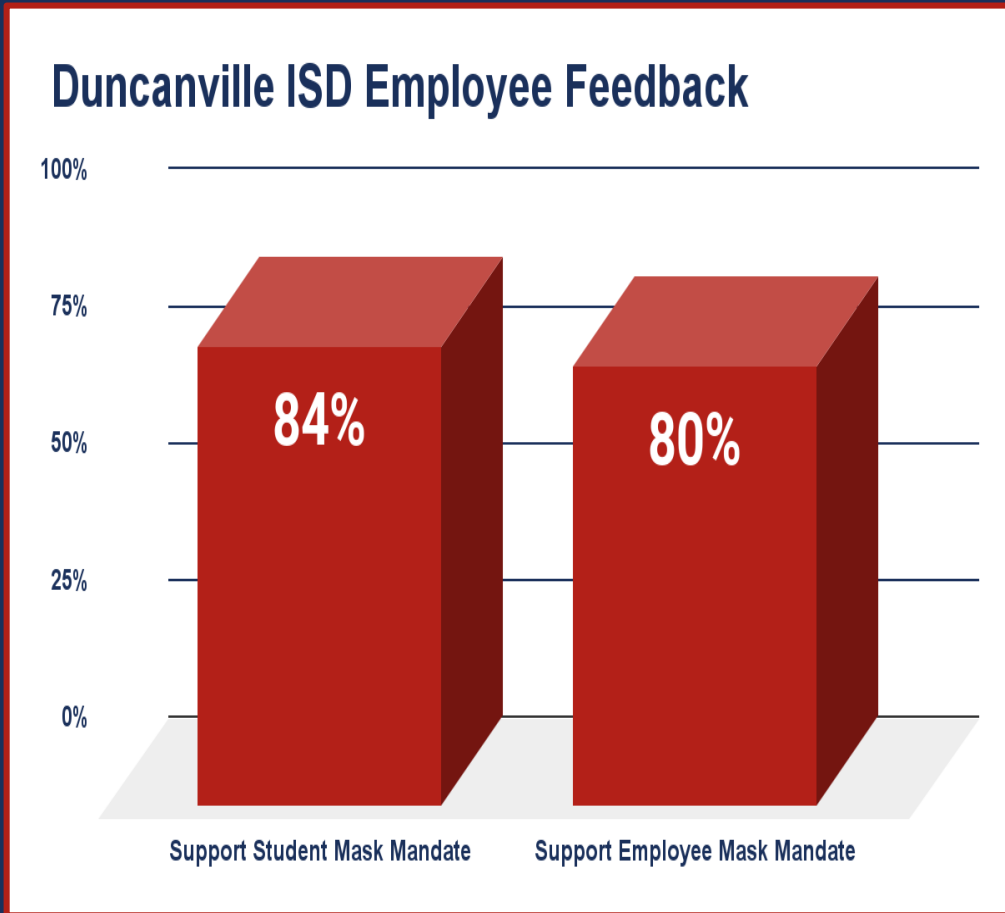

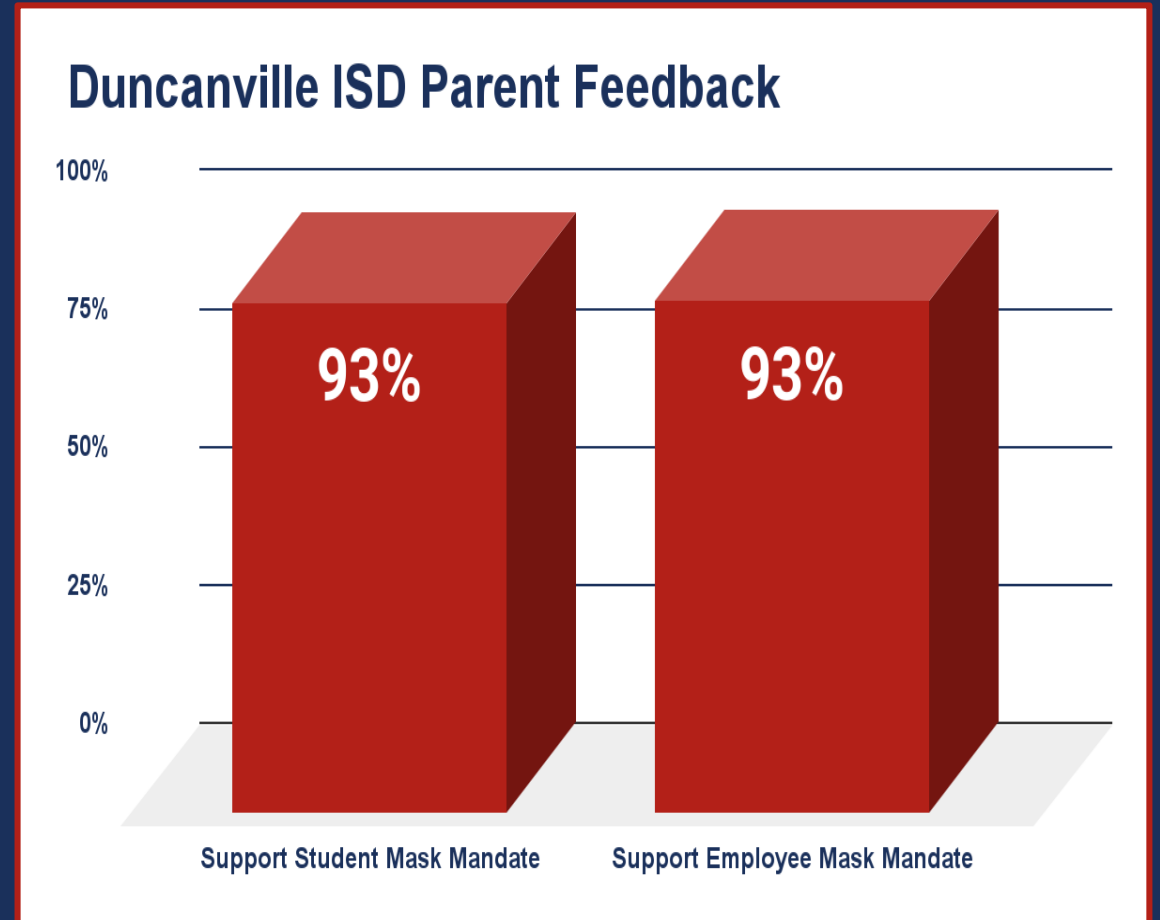
