School Year 2021-2022

Student Experiencing COVID-Like Symptoms
(Vaccinated / Unvaccinated)



Go To Isolation Room
Until Guardian Picks Up Student



Get Evaluated by a Healthcare Provider (HCP)

Stay Home

Get a COVID-19 Test



HCP advises to get a
COVID-19 test
(Follow +/- Rules)

HCP gives alternate diagnosis
AND determines COVID-19 test
is not indicated

STAY HOME



STAY HOME UNTIL:

- * Fever free without medications for 24-hours, AND
- * Symptoms improve, AND
- * One of the following:
 - Test negative for SARS-CoV-2, OR
 - HCP has provided documentation that the symptoms are typical of their underlying chronic condition (ex. allergies or asthma), OR
 - 10 Days have passed since 1st symptom appeared

(+) Positive Test

- * Notify school of positive test
- * Isolate & stay home until
- * Fever free without medications for 24-hours, AND
- * Symptoms improve, AND
- * 10 Days have passed since 1st symptom appeared

(-) Negative

STAY AT HOME UNTIL:

- * Fever free without medications for 24-hours, AND
- * Symptoms improve

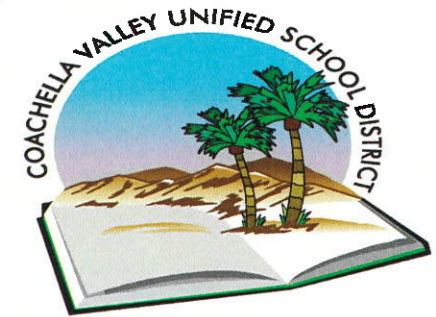
Return To School



COVID-19 Symptoms Include But Are Not Limited To:

- * Fever ≥ 100.4 °F or chills
- * Shortness of breath
- * Cough
- * Headache
- * Sore throat
- * New loss of taste or smell
- * Fatigue
- * Muscle or body aches
- * Diarrhea
- * Nausea or vomiting
- * *Congestion or runny nose* **
- * *Red or itchy eyes* **

** Students with underlying medical conditions, parents should consult with the student's medical provider to determine if the student is medically safe to be at school. (Ex. Can include ability to wear a mask due to diagnosis, asthmatic students who require nebulizer treatments, etc.)



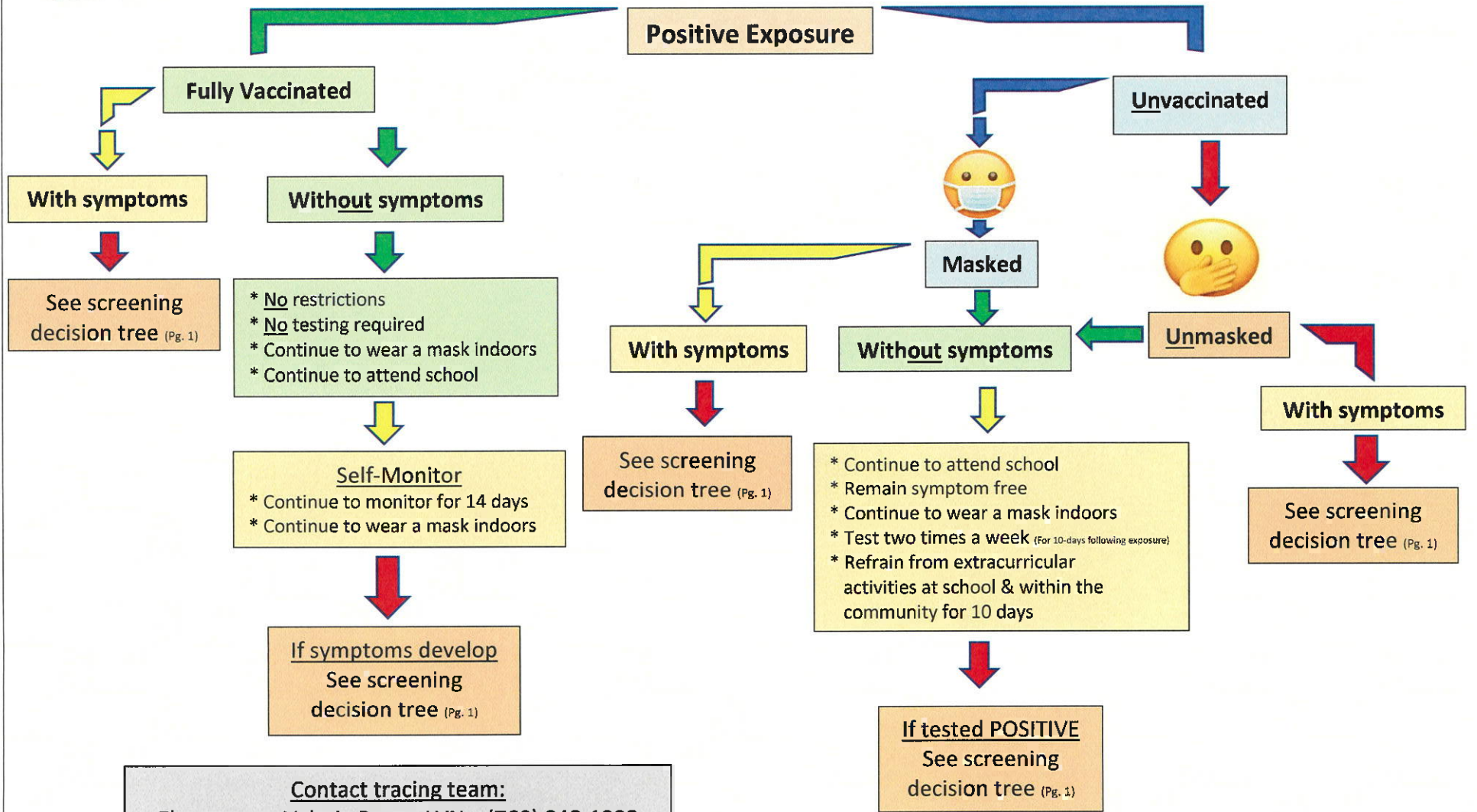

****EXPOSURE CRITERIA****
 Must have been within 0-6ft. distance of a COVID-19 positive person, for greater than 15 cumulative minutes over 24-hour period.
