

COVID-19 SYMPTOMS:

- Fever 100.4 or higher
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Headache
- Chills
- Congestion or runny nose
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Sore throat
- New loss of smell or taste
- Unusual fatique
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Other signs of new illness that are unrelated to a preexisting condition (such as seasonal allergies)

CLOSE CONTACT MEANS:

Being within 6 feet of someone diagnosed with COVID-19 for about 15 minutes. All students and teachers within a cohort are considered close contacts.

SCREEN FOR COVID-19

- No symptoms
- No diagnosis
- No close contact
- No symptoms
- Close contact of someone with COVID-19
- No symptoms
- Tested **POSITIVE for** COVID-19
- Has 1 or more COVID-19 symptom(s)
- Tested NEGATIVE for COVID-19
- Has 1 or more COVID-19 symptom(s)
- Tested POSITIVE for COVID-19 or had NO TEST

VACCINATED

Does not need to quarantine unless symptomatic. Should be tested 3-5 days following a known exposure to someone with

suspected or

confirmed

COVID-19.

NON-**VACCINATED**

Can return after quarantining for 14 days from the last date of close contact. Must still quarantine for 14 days if they test negative for

COVID-19.

Can return after **quarantining** for 10 days since the positive results. If

symptoms
