# Daily Symptom Checker



- Each student, faculty and staff member will be required to review a provided daily symptom checker before entering the building each day
- If anyone is experiencing any of the symptoms, they are asked to notify the school and stay home

#### **Symptoms**

- Fever or chills
- New cough
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Fatigue
- Headache

- New congestion
- New runny nose
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

#### ST. MARY'S HEALTH CHECKER CARD

Every morning prior to arriving on campus, please check to see if you have:



- Fever or chills
- New cough
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat



- Fatigue
- Headache
- New congestion or new runny nose



- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If you are experiencing any of these symptoms above and/or don't feel well for any reason, please notify the school and stay home.

### Masks



- All staff and students will be required to wear a mask while indoors on school property
- Masks will not be required outdoors
- Masks will be required on any school transportation
- Each student will receive St. Mary's issued masks
  - 5 will be given: 1 gifted, 4 purchased by family at a cost of \$24





## **Academic Instruction**

- Academic instruction will be in-person only for all students every day
- Remote learning will not be offered as an option for the 2021-22 school year
- If there is an unforeseen shut down due to government issued order,
   we are prepared to switch to remote-only learning immediately





## Sports and Extracurricular Activities

- Sports are currently scheduled for the Fall
- Masks will be required for all indoor sports games and practices
- Extracurricular Activities will continue this Fall



## **Enhanced Cleaning Protocols**

- Additional cleaning staff has been added to clean campus
- Enhanced cleaning materials are available to aid in disinfecting surfaces
- Touchless hand sanitizing dispensers are located throughout campus







## Student Health

- If a student is not feeling well during the school day they should report to the Nurse's office
- If a student's symptoms are those associated with COVID-19, they will be placed in an isolation room
- The student's parent/guardian will be notified and must be picked up from campus immediately
  - It is important that all emergency contacts be updated
- Nurse Lisa Morin-Plante is certified in Johns Hopkins University & Medicine COVID-19 contact tracing protocols
- Dr. Richard Cuneo will serve as the Physician Advisor for St. Mary's
  - Board Certified Pediatrician



## Vaccination

- Vaccination for eligible members of our community is highly encouraged
- All vaccinated members of our community should upload proof of vaccination though the portal
- Vaccination information will be kept on file and will allow St. Mary's to follow proper protocol according to vaccination status



# **Exposure Protocol**

- If you are vaccinated\* and exposed, and demonstrate no symptoms, quarantine will not be required
  - You will be required to provide a negative test between the third and fifth day after exposure
- If you are not vaccinated and exposed, regardless of presence of symptoms, you must quarantine until the eighth day from exposure and have a negative test result taken on day five or later from exposure

\* Proof of vaccination must be on file through the school portal



### Communication

- St. Mary's commits to notifying the community of any COVID positive cases on campus when the school year begins.
- The two-tier communication will first be contacting any individual who is considered a direct contact.
- The second will be notifying the community of the positive case.
- No identities of COVID-19 positive individuals will be shared at any time.



## **Travel Protocol**

- If you are vaccinated \* and travel domestically, no test and no quarantine is required upon return
- If you are not vaccinated and travel domestically, you must quarantine until you receive a negative test on day 5 of return
- All international travelers must quarantine until you receive a negative test on day 5 of return

\* Proof of vaccination must be on file through the school portal
