

Pequannock Township School District Curriculum Syllabus

Elementary Spanish / Grade 5

Course Description:

Research shows that Individuals who demonstrate proficiency when communicating in more than one language, have an appropriate understanding of cultural contexts, and are globally literate and possess the attributes reflected in the mission and vision for world languages. The mission of world language instruction provides students and individuals with a broad world view as global citizens. A commitment to world language instruction provides opportunity for individuals to function in an array of occupations and careers and helps develop and exhibits values and empathy regarding cultural differences that are reflected in the diverse society that makes up the United States.

This course is designed to provide students with an introduction to language learning in a fun, interactive way. The course is provided by Middlebury Interactive and focuses on authentic story-telling, myths, and legends to expose young learners to the basics of a language. The course is a self-guided program in which students can progress at a pace that is appropriate for them. The ACTFL Proficiency Benchmarks are Novice Low to Novice Mid. Students will engage in Interpersonal Speaking components throughout the course of instruction. The course is designed to be completed over a two-year period, setting students up to proceed with their language instruction in middle school.
