


# Common App – Entering your colleges






All colleges entered into your Common App account should match your Naviance "Colleges I'm Applying To" list

# Common App – Entering your personal information




### Common App – be thorough and accurate

#### Common App – Review and Submit, Fee Waiver




Member colleges want to make sure that application fees do not pose a barrier for any student who wishes to apply for admission.


Do you feel that your financial circumstances might qualify you for an application fee waiver? If you answer YES, you will check off 1 of 8 options for why you qualify.

Examples, you received a waiver for an SAT or ACT OR you qualify for free and reduced lunch, etc. Do not hesitate to answer yes!






#### Common App — Family Educational Rights to Privacy Act (FERPA) Waiver



### Common App – Optional Information

#### Resumé:

Students can attach their resume to their Common App under the writing tab in the additional information section. Due to the fact that the Common App only allows for 10 activities, a student can use their resume to further highlight their activities.

# Portfolio – SlideRoom with Common App:

 Applicants are presented a link within Common App to submit a Portfolio for each school's SlideRoom account. Clicking the Portfolio link will take them out of Common App and into a specific school's SlideRoom account for submitting media-based representations of their project


# The Self-Reported Academic Record

- Used by some colleges and universities in addition to or instead of The Common App or other college applications
- The SRAR allows you to enter, track, and submit your academic record electronically to participating colleges and universities
- The student enters the courses and associated grades that you have completed or will be completing into the system, and it is transmitted electronically to the colleges who request it
- Have a copy of your transcript close by before starting
- Purpose for the SRAR




SELF-REPORTED ACADEMIC RECORD


