Kindergarten Parents

If you are a kindergarten parent, you will be receiving a letter in the mail regarding our Kindergarten Experience Monday, August 23rd as well as other details for the start of the school year.

Kindergarten Start Dates

This year, our Kindergarteners will have a staggered start, meaning your Kindergarten student will start school on *either* Tuesday, Sept 7, Wednesday Sept. 8 or Thursday Sept. 9. About one-third of our Kindergarten students will attend on each of these days. We sent an email earlier this summer taking your requests for start dates. We will do our best to try to accommodate your request. Please note that we cannot guarantee days as we need to balance the number of students for each day. The staggered start is intended to ease your child into school and allow the teacher to provide more support to students on the first day. You can expect an email from our secretary, Mrs. Eaton regarding your child's start date on Tuesday, August 24th. Shortly after this email, your student's teacher will be sending an email to sign you up for your Family Connection Meeting. Kindergarten will be conducting **Family Connection meetings on September 1st, 2nd, 3rd.**

COVID Safety & Building Implementation

We know you probably have a lot of questions regarding the implementation of safety procedures regarding COVID. We believe maintaining school safety is critical and we value transparent

communication with students and families regarding adjustments and/or changes of safety practice. Safety plans and procedures will be based on guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), Department of Health (DOH), Seattle and King County Public Health as well as state and district directives.

Here is the current guidance:

- Mask requirements throughout the day for both staff and students
- Parents/Families will need to wear masks in our school at all times regardless of vaccination status
- NO daily attestation for your student
- Physical distancing to the greatest extent possible
- Students will be eating in our lunchroom, seated at least three feet from each other.
- Masks are required on our buses and seating charts will be implemented
- Handwashing and or hand sanitizing will still be priority throughout the day
- Strict health monitoring and reporting protocols
- Cleaning protocols implemented throughout the day
- Limited indoor cohort interactions
