Points of Emphasis:

- FCA will open on August 24, 2020, with in-person education.
- Parents, guardians and caregivers should review the "Covid Symptoms/Exposure Checklist" (coming soon) every day and plan to keep their child home if they are exhibiting any symptoms. FCA will not be screening temperatures.
- Regarding face coverings, all parents/guardians will need to sign a waiver (see attached documents) for their student(s).
- Distance learning will not take place unless FCA is closed due to COVID-19.
- Lunches will include hot meals.
- Busing - If the school district in which student(s) reside is closed due to COVID-19, parents/guardians would be responsible for the transportation of their child(ren).
- FCA continues to adjust its cleaning protocol and requirements as needed.
- FCA understands the need for students to socialize and interact and will provide ways for that to be done in a healthy and safe manner (Example: recess/gym/lunch).

Thank you for your patience as we navigate through the mountains of information surrounding this virus. It is the goal of the Academy to provide our students with the best education in a safe environment where they can grow spiritually, socially, and academically.
