Voluntary Student Accident Insurance

Children of US Military Personnel

According to the Illinois School Code, school districts are required to report to the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) the number of enrolled students identified as children of US military personnel. We have now included, on our enrollment form, the opportunity for the individual enrolling the student to voluntarily state whether the student has a parent or guardian who is a member of a branch of the armed forces of the United States and who is either deployed to active duty or expects to be deployed to active duty during the school year. This may be reported at the time of enrollment or at any time during the school year.

District Procedure for Consecutive Absences

District 99 will drop any student who is absent for more than 10 consecutive school days of attendance. Medical reasons and/or other reasons for excessive, consecutive absences must be communicated to the school and approved through the Asst. Superintendent for Educational Services office. If a student is dropped, he/she will need to re-register and complete the full registration process.
