Following her college graduation, she taught English and Journalism at Pleasant Hill High School, Pleasant Hill, OR. Beginning in 1974 she worked in the business office at the University of Oregon retiring in 2000 as the supervisor of the Cashiers Office.

Before coming to Willamina, Carolyn was a devoted member of United Lutheran Church in Eugene, Oregon. At the time of her death she was a member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Willamina, having served on the church council and most recently as the council secretary, and the pastor's legs.
