

Laptop Fines for Damage, Theft, and Loss

The Laptop Agreement Form states that parents and students have read everything in the Student Laptop Handbook and agree to it. **Page 5 contains the cost for families if a laptop is damaged, lost, or stolen. This cost is required regardless of the situation.** The only way to avoid this cost is to purchase Laptop Insurance through the district. You can do this by visiting the EHS technology website and click on the insurance link. Please note that there is a 30 day waiting period for damage claims on the policy.
