


Grade 1 Math Review Activities

Activity 1	Addition Pictures	Use the addition pictures below. Tell a family member what you notice about the picture. Make up an addition story using the picture. Write the addition sentence and share it with your family member. <i>Example: There were 2 bees at the hive. 3 more bees arrived. Now there are 5 bees at the hive. $2+3=5$</i>
Activity 2	More or Less	Practice more or less with a family member. Use playing cards (without the face cards), divide the deck evenly between 2 people (20 cards each). Place your piles face down. Turn over your top cards and talk about which number is more and which is less . The player with the larger number takes the cards. Repeat until you use all the cards in the pile. Activity 3	Mrs. Wishy – Washy’s Farm <i>A Story Problem</i> 	<p>Watch the video of the story “Mrs. Wishy Washy’s Farm” Joy Cowley. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cizS3vyV8ks</p> <p>Solve this problem. Mrs. Wishy Washy washed some more animals. They had in total 16 legs. What animals did she bathe?</p> <p>OR... Pretend you are Mrs. Wishy Washy. Write a math word problem that you think she might have to solve on her farm.</p>
Activity 4	Sums of 5	Watch the video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wTgRu4E4vtc Write all the ways you know how to make 5. Use pictures, numbers and words to show your combinations. Here are examples: $1 + 4 = 5$ OR a picture of 1 circle and 4 rectangles with a total of 5 shapes OR... ADDITION MATCH IT CARDS. Cut out the addition facts and sums in this packet. Mix them up and practice matching the addition fact to its sum with a family member.

Hide some of the counters under the cup and make a subtraction sentence. <i>Example: You hide 3 counters under the cup. 3 counters under the cup, you see 2 counters, there are 5 counters all together.</i> Write $5 - 3 = 2$ Keep playing hiding different numbers.

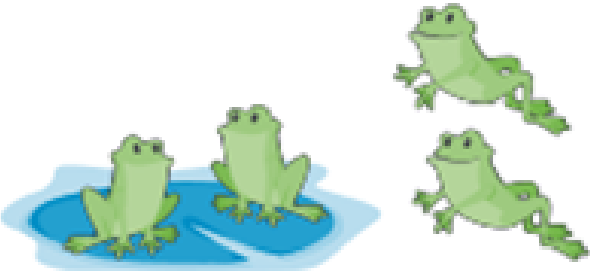

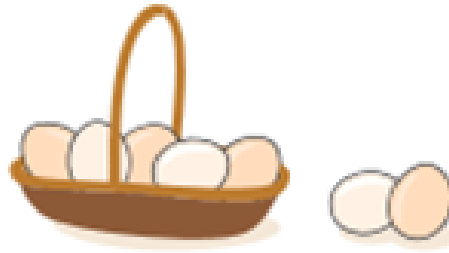

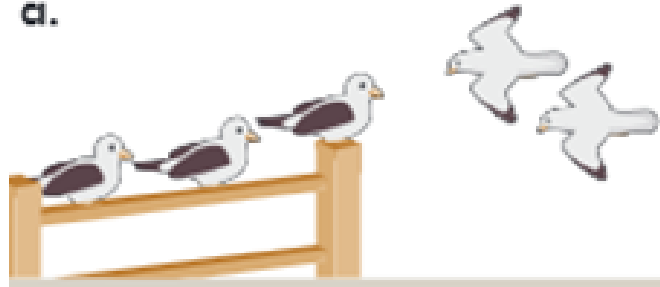
