Draw a big line that wiggles and loops around your paper. Add some overlapping geometrical shapes. Color in the new shapes you created different colors to make your artwork like Matthew's art. Change colors where new shapes appear. (Think of your line as a fence, each color stays inside the fence around it.)

**Grade One and Two
Cupcakes**

Follow the instructions to create a colorful cupcake!
Try to come up with new styles and flavors!



Grade Two and Three Value Ice Cream Cone

Value is the lightness or darkness of a color.

Create an ice cream cone with three scoops. With a crayon or pencil, color the bottom scoop as DARK as you can. Using the same crayon or pencil, color the scoop above it just a little lighter, using less pressure to color the shape. The next scoop above that one uses the lightest pressure to make it the lightest in color.


For an extra challenge, try making another ice cream cone with more scoops! Fill each scoop in the same way, experimenting with pressure to show value in your scoops from darkest to lightest.





Grade Four Line Design Bugs

INSECTS IN LINE

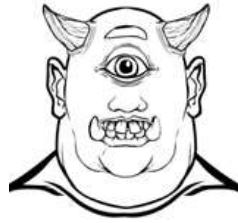


1. Use shapes to design six imaginary bugs. Be sure to vary the shapes of wings, bodies, legs, and heads.
2. Draw the bugs with a pencil first. Don't just draw the bugs in a line—place them all over the paper.

 - ← Boring
 - ← Exciting
3. Outline your pencil lines with a black pen. Make up some different line designs to fill in the blank spaces of the insects' bodies.
4. Make the wings look see-through. Fill the wings with a design when part of the insect's body should show through from underneath.


Drawing simple lines in the wings will make it look like the bug is moving.
5. Fill your whole paper with insect drawings.
