Swim had the most state qualifiers of any school in the state.

Boys' basketball had a winning record for the first time in about 5 years.

Meeting was held 3/4/21-Jenny Pelko and Cameron Ryba spoke:

In process of planning summer school with in person, online, asynchronous, and other options. Some students will be invited for remediation and other classes offered for credit. Most classes will be offered 6/7-7/1 and the district is looking into transportation for students enrolled in summer school.

Elementary-Remote or in person

Middle School- Asynchronous, group and individual in person sessions, and using APEX platform. Also, band and orchestra camp

High School-APEX platform, ACT prep, for credit courses (these are traditionally in person but might be offered online) and group and individual in person sessions.

The district is also looking to add before and after care to all elementary schools. Currently, only offered at Muraski.

The district is pausing any international travel at the high school level due to the need for a negative COVID test prior to reentry to the USA.

A renewal levy is on the November '21 ballot. No new taxes.

All state and national PTA meeting will be held on a virtual basis this year.

Council is in the process of making PBIS scholarship selections.
