IX. Council Delegate's Report - Allison Applebee, Misti Schulz, Katherine Schoenberger Dr. Ryba Report:

Esser Funds Rec'd

-District is receiving approximately 6.1 Million dollars from Federal government to help support district. These funds have specific criteria on how they can be used. The funds must be used to prevent, prepare for and respond to Covid19 pandemic.

-At least 20% of the funds (approx. 1M) need to be allocated to loss of learning – summer learning programs.

-We have renewal levy in November, the Esser funds are completely separate dollars than the Levy funds.

The Esser funds will be used for summer programs, software/programs, professional development, capital improvements, creating new positions.

-Some of the new positions created are:

1) Secondary Math Coach – to address learning gaps in math grades 6-12

2) Elementary School Guidance Counselor – this would be the 5<sup>th</sup> one added to district so that every elementary will have one.

3) Elementary Assistant Principal – primarily focused at Muraski & Kinsner because of the larger number of students at those elementary schools. Also, will help with overall district needs.

4) Potential Position of a Covid Coordinator – this might possibly be a part time/contracted position. Still undetermined at this time.

5) Elementary Reading Specialists

6) MTSS Coordinators (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support). Possibly hire 2 for district.

7) Intervention specialist

8) Special Education Instructional Coach

A. 9) Social Worker – currently have 1 1/2, looking to expand to 2 full time.

Dr. Ryba also discussed Middle School Challenges.

Concerns with how kids are treating each other, the words used / hateful, mean spirited. Middle school had an assembly to address with students on 5/6 to start the process of repairing and encouraging better respect towards each other and better support for kids/parents/staff to improve behavior.
