### A Few Mind Shifting Tips for Cultivating a Growth Mindset at Home

- <u>Help children reconnect with a time when they learned something new that was a stretch or a</u> <u>challenge.</u> Point out the developmental nature of "getting good". We all go through the process of making a lot of mistakes, practicing, and then getting better.
- Help children get curious about mistakes. Help them reframe a mistake as "new information" or as a <u>"step" in the learning process.</u> In addition, help them incorporate self-correction in their own learning process.
- 3. <u>Help children learn to hear their own "fixed mindset" voice.</u> Capture and in a gentle and appropriate way, share their own statements with them. Most children are unaware of this self-talk because it's gone on so long and is subliminal.
  - a. That guy is brilliant; he never tries and he gets it.
  - b. I got it wrong again! I'll never get this.

### 4. <u>Help children talk back to negative self-talk with a growth mindset voice.</u>

- a. I am willing to learn new skills to improve and I know it might be hard at times.
- b. I get better and better with practice. This is hard, but it will get easier.
- c. Practice makes permanent!

### 5. Model growth-mindset at the table.

a. At dinner ask: Tell me about a time when you didn't know the answer to a recent question. Who did you ask for help? How did you learn the answer?

### 6. Avoid labels and give growth-mindset praise.

- a. Don't label yourself in ways that model a fixed mindset. Ex. I'm a terrible cook or I was never good at math.
- b. Shift your child's attention to the process that led to the outcome.
- c. Praise and value effort, practice, self-correction and persistence.
- d. Don't shelter your child from a failed task. Instead, ask: What can you learn from this experience? What could you do differently next time?

### 7. <u>Get curious about your child's work through questioning.</u>

- a. How did you figure that out?
- b. What's another way you could have done that?
- c. How many times did you try before it turned out that way?
- d. What was challenging and how did you figure it out?
- e. What do you plan to do next time?

On behalf of the Rib Mountain Elementary School and PTO, we invite you to join us as a vendor at the annual Rib Mountain PTO Fall Bazaar. The event will be Saturday, November 13, 2021, from 8:00am – 3:00pm at Rib Mountain Elementary School located at 150801 Robin Lane.

If you are interested in joining us this year, please complete the enclosed **Vendor Registration Form** and return along with a **check** to the address below. Please make checks payable to Rib Mountain PTO. If you have provided an email address, you will receive confirmation by email. **We appreciate completed registrations and payment by Monday, September 20, 2021.** 

Returning vendors will be given priority registration; however, it is expected that <u>all</u> vendors will meet the September 20th deadline for this to apply. A waiting list will be created for other interested vendors effective Tuesday, September 21, 2021. The waiting list will operate on a first-come, first serve basis. We reserve the right to limit the number of similar vendors to ensure an optimum sales opportunity; in particular, direct sales vendors. **Other specific space location requests** can be made, but please know that there is <u>no</u> guarantee they will be honored. This includes preferences regarding hallway spaces.

**There will be no food pre-order form again this year.** Food could be ordered and paid for the morning of the event and would be delivered to your booth.

We are excited to have you participate in our annual PTO/Rib Mountain Elementary Fall Bazaar and we appreciate your support! In an effort to increase foot traffic, we have invested more for advertising. We have also increased the number of vendor spaces available. In order to do that, we created spaces in our hallways. All spaces, regardless of their location, measure close to  $60^2$  ft. We have spaces in the gymnasium (10X6) =  $60^2$  ft. and we have spaces in the hallway that vary due to the width of the hallway:

 $(3.5 \times 17.5 \text{ ft.}) = 61.25^{2} \text{ ft.}$   $(4 \times 15 \text{ ft.}) = 60^{2} \text{ ft.}$   $(4.5 \times 13.5 \text{ ft.}) = 60.7^{2} \text{ ft.}$ 

We will fill the spaces in the gym first and then move to fill spaces in the hallway. As noted, if you prefer a certain sized hallway space to better accommodate your booth set up, you can indicate that on the registration form. While guarantees cannot be made, efforts to accommodate your wishes will be made. The best way to guarantee your wishes is to register and submit your payment early!

## Rib Mountain PTO Fall Bazaar 2021 Vendor General Information

Show Hours: Advertised hours will be from 8:00am until 3:00pm. Please have your booth ready by 7:45am.

**Setup & Tear down**: Setup hours will be held on Friday, November 12<sup>th</sup> from 4:30pm – 6:30pm and on Saturday, November 13<sup>th</sup> starting at 6:45am. No early arrivals/setups will be allowed. Tear down will begin immediately at the close of the event and we ask that you be finished by 3:45pm.

Advertising: We will provide event advertising and a listing of vendors & crafters on various media outlets, City Pages, and radio stations.

**Electricity**: Limited spaces with access to an outlet are available. <u>You must provide your own extension cords</u>; cords must be in good condition. <u>Painters tape</u> may be used to secure any exposed cords. All tape used to cover cords must be removed at the end of the event by the vendor.

**Vendors**: We reserve the right to select all vendors and types of items sold at the event. Each vendor is responsible for his/her items the day of the event. Rib Mountain PTO is not responsible for any lost or stolen items or for equipment other than that supplied by the school and PTO. Vendor spaces are limited and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis for space location. We will do our <u>best</u> to accommodate space requests, but cannot guarantee that requests will be honored.

**Parking**: Vendors may park in the school parking lot near the gym. During setup and take down time periods, the rear gym doors will be open. (This is door #5 and it will be unlocked for your use.) Please don't block the entrance/exit/ doorways with your vehicle. Please unload your items and then move your vehicle away from the building to make room for others to do the same. Thank you.

**Food**: Food, beverages, snacks, and baked goods will be on sale throughout the day. All proceeds benefit the school and our PTO. There will be no pre-order forms for food. Food items can be ordered and paid for the morning of the event and would be delivered to your booth between **11:30am- 12:00 pm.** 

**Building Regulations**: Absolutely NO smoking or alcoholic beverages will be permitted on school property. No concealed weapons or firearms of any kind are permitted. <u>Please retain from bringing pets into our school building</u>. It's too soon to know if we will be required to wear masks.
