

Vaccinated Student Quarantine Policy

If your child is not fully vaccinated against COVID-19, they are subject to the main CDS COVID-19 Quarantine Policies. <u>Community Day School considers a person to be fully</u> <u>vaccinated against COVID-19 after receiving two doses of the vaccination, plus</u> <u>completing the waiting period of two weeks</u>. Please note that <u>if CDS has proof that</u> <u>your child has been infected with COVID-19 within 90 days of a classwide quarantine, that child will not be required to complete an additional quarantine and may instead return to school for in-person, on-campus learning.</u>

<u>Community Day School must receive all COVID-19 test results via</u> <u>health@communityday.org.</u>

If your child is fully vaccinated, the quarantine policy is as follows:

- After being informed of a COVID-19 positive in the classroom, a fully vaccinated student <u>does not need to quarantine</u> however he/she must return with a negative test taken on or after the date of classwide quarantine.
- If a student is fully vaccinated, but a person residing in their home tests
 positive for COVID-19, the student must quarantine at home for the duration of
 the other person's quarantine, then test negative before returning to campus.

- If a student is fully vaccinated but tests positive for COVID-19, the student must follow the CDS quarantine policy for all individuals who test positive (<u>click</u> <u>here to learn more</u>).
