



# COVID-19 Attestation and Commitment to Conduct Daily Health Screenings

*To maintain the health, safety and well-being of our students, staff, and community during the 2021-2022 school year, the South Kitsap School District requires this COVID-19 Attestation and Agreement be completed for all students before attendance on campus or at school-based activities.*

As the parent/guardian to the student(s) listed on this form, I **attest and agree** that I will conduct, or will ensure a caregiver conducts, the following health screening for my student each day prior to them arriving at school, riding a school bus, or engaging in any school activity located on or off South Kitsap School District property.

By sending your student to school, you attest that the answer to each question below is **NO**. If you can answer **YES** to any of the questions below, you agree to keep your student home from school and to contact their school to excuse the absence, report why the child did not pass the health screening and determine when they may return.

1. Has your student experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours?

Fever (100.4 or higher) or chills	Recent loss of taste or smell
Cough	Sore throat
Fatigue	Congestion/runny nose
Muscle or body aches	Nausea or vomiting
Headache	Diarrhea (2 or more episodes in 24 hours)
Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing	<sup>^</sup> not related to a medically documented chronic illness (i.e., asthma, migraine)

2. Is your student currently waiting on results of a COVID-19 test because they have experienced any symptom(s) listed above?
3. Has your student tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days?

If your student has **recovered** from a **COVID-19 infection in the last 90 days, skip question 4, otherwise continuing reading and answer carefully:**

4. In the last 14 days, has your student been in close contact (6 feet or closer for 15 or more cumulative minutes during a 24-hour period) with anyone with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19?



- Note: If your student is **fully vaccinated\*** and you answered yes to question 4, they may come to school if they do not have symptoms listed above but will be required to receive a COVID-19 test 3-5 days after exposure.

*\*to be considered fully vaccinated, it must be at least 2 weeks since receiving the second dose in a two-dose series or 2 weeks since receiving a single dose vaccine*

I understand that my student cannot attend school or school related activities when experiencing COVID-19 symptoms. If I send my student to school with any COVID-19 symptoms or they develop symptoms at school, they will immediately be isolated, I will be notified, and my student will need to be picked up immediately. I will be required to work with the school to determine when my child can return. I understand the COVID-19 guidance is subject to change and may be updated as new information is received by South Kitsap School District.
