



Based on updated guidance released by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) last week, the Fairfax County Health Department recommends that everyone, including individuals fully vaccinated against COVID-19, wear a mask in public indoor settings. As the number of COVID-19 cases continues to increase with the spread of the Delta variant, this recommendation is based on the Fairfax Health District moving from moderate level of COVID-19 transmission to substantial transmission. All individuals in Virginia who are 12 or older are

GETTING BACK INTO PHYSICAL SHAPE – Oh, don't we hate the sound of that! But, after more than a year of being cooped up inside, stopping our usual activities, and seeing fewer friends and family members, most of us have noticed a big difference in how we feel. Now that Summer is beginning to wane, this is a good time to begin thinking about the things we can do to get ourselves into better shape with cooler weather on the horizon. Experts warn us that if we don't address issues that have arisen during the pandemic – muscle weakness, poor nutrition, disrupted sleep, anxiety, social isolation, and more –older adults face the prospect of poorer health and increased frailty. What can we do, then, to address challenges of this kind?

Well, several experts share some advice, suggestions you might consider. One is to reconnect with your physician. Schedule a visit with your primary care physician and catch up with preventive care screenings as well as having your functioning addressed. If you're having difficulty climbing stairs or walking a quarter-mile, you might benefit from physical therapy. Ask your doctor for a referral. Make sure you get back on track with your dentist - good oral health is really important. Start slow and build steadily. Pace yourself, listen to your body, and don't do anything that causes discomfort or pain. Be physically active. Engaging regularly in physical activity of some kind – a walk in the park, chair exercises at home, video fitness programs – is the experts' top recommendation. There are many different classes available right here at the Vienna Community Center that will make it easy for you to get going.

Have realistic expectations. If you're reluctant to get started, try a little bit of activity and see how you feel. Then try a little more and see if that's okay. This kind of repeated exposure is a good way to deal with any hesitation or fear. Understand that this has been a time of psychological trauma for many people, and it's impacted the way we behave. We can't go back to pre-pandemic activity and engagement like turning on a light switch; we need to respect what our limits are. Eat well. Adequate protein consumption is even more important for older adults during times of stress or when we're sedentary and not getting much activity. Establish routines. Having a structure to the day that involves social interactions, whether virtual or in-person, and various activities, including some time outside when the weather is good, is important to older adults. End-if-day routines are equally important in addressing sleep problems, which have increased in older people since the pandemic.

Reconnect socially. Mental health problems have also worsened in a segment of the older population because of the pandemic. An increase in anxiety, sadness or depression, and worry has been reported. And social isolation and loneliness may be contributing. Being vaccinated has eased this somewhat, but it's important to try to have in-person connections with someone every day. Even a walk outdoors might end up in a pleasant exchange with a neighbor that could get those endorphins flowing, helping to lift your spirits. As you can see, getting into better physical shape is much more than simply doing exercises. - it's a package deal! And remember, it's never, ever too late to start! 
