

**Interdistrict Attendance**

The Board of Education recognizes that students who reside in one district may be interested in attending school in another district and that such choices are made for a variety of reasons. The Board desires to communicate with parents/guardians and students regarding the educational programs and services that are available.

*(cf. 5111.1 – District Residency)*

*(cf. 5116.1 - Intradistrict Open Enrollment)*

*(cf. 5145.6 - Parental Notifications)*

For each approved interdistrict request, the District shall enter into an agreement with the other involved school district as authorized by law. The interdistrict attendance agreement is valid for one school year only. The parents/guardian of the student must reapply each year for interdistrict attendance. Parents/guardians requesting interdistrict attendance for their students shall be informed of this requirement, and apprised of the fact that the request may not be renewed in future years.

Upon receiving a permit for transfer into the district that has been approved by the student's district of residence, or upon receiving a written request from the parent/guardian of a district student who wishes to enroll in another district, the Superintendent or designee shall review the request and may approve or deny the permit subject to the terms and conditions of the interdistrict attendance agreement.

**Transportation**

The district shall not provide transportation beyond any school attendance area unless required by law.
