# **PRINCIPAL COMMENTS**

### Site

- Would like to replace sand at the playgrounds with rubber surfacing.
- Would like to install a shade structure over outdoor assembly area.
- The perimeter fencing along the south side of the school site has seen some vandalism and can be a security issue.
- Drainage between finger buildings is a problem.
- Would like an updated monument sign.
- Flooding on the southeast side of campus occurs frequently.

- Need cool down areas for behavioral issues;
   a safer space with padded surfaces is desired.
- There is currently no Multi-Purpose Room (MPR).



- Currently use a classroom as the Parent Center.
- Would like better separation in office areas for confidential conversations.
- There is a concern of mold in conference rooms.
- Would like to remove the black box in the office and would like new floor covering in office.
