Annual Parent Notice of Right to Request Teacher Qualifications

School: Boys' Latin of Philadelphia

Date: August 29, 2021

Boys' Latin of Philadelphia ("Boys' Latin" or "the school") receives federal funds for programs that are part of the Elementary and Secondary Act ("ESEA"), as amended in 2015. Throughout the school year, the school will continue to provide you with important information about this law and your student's education. Based on current education law, teachers must have earned State certification and licensure. State certification and licensure is the training required to be a teacher.

If you request this information, Boys' Latin will provide you with the following as soon as possible:

- If the teacher has met state certification and licensing requirements for the grade levels and subjects for which the teacher provides instruction.
- If state certification and licensing requirements have been waived (is not being required at this time) for the teacher under emergency or other temporary status.
- If the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline for which they are certified or licensed.
- If the teacher has met State-approved or State-recognized certification, licensing, registration, or other comparable requirements. These requirements apply to the professional discipline in which the teacher is working and may include providing English language instruction to English learners, special education, or related services to students with disabilities, or both.
- If your student is receiving Title I or special education services from paraprofessionals, their qualifications.
