

****Class Schedules-** Schedules will be viewable in skyward on July 26th. Although they are viewable, they are not final. Counselors have just begun the very difficult task of working on schedules that are incomplete or have conflicts. Your patience is greatly appreciated. If you do have a problem with your schedule please fill out this [Schedule Change Request Form](#) (must be done by the student). Do not call or email your counselor with schedule change requests. All requests must be submitted **BY THE STUDENT** via the Google Form. **Schedule change requests will not be accepted after August 4th.**

Only requests that meet the criteria below will be accepted:

- You are missing a graduation requirement.
- Your schedule is incomplete or a class is duplicated.
- You are enrolled in a course that you have already completed and received credit.
- You are enrolled in a course for which you have not met the prerequisite.
- You have a physical injury that does not allow participation in a course.
- You have a signature program error or conflict.
- A teacher has recommended you for a course or has changed his/her recommendation.
- You wish to increase or decrease the rigor of your schedule- assuming space is available.
- **SMS Withdrawal Form-** If your student(s) will not be attending SMS this fall please fill out this form at your earliest convenience. [SMS Withdrawal Link](#)
- Visit [Johnson County Mental Health Center](#) and [Johnson County Family Resources](#) for family/adolescent support.



Getting the COVID-19 Vaccine? If you have both doses, please send us a copy so we can add to your Skyward Vaccine list. This could help you with any quarantine situations we may run into.

Did you see your doctor this summer? Did you get an immunization? ANY vaccine you get, send that information into our office. We will update Skyward for you. Anyone turning 16, please remember that you will need your 2nd Meningitis Vaccine. This is a state requirement for you to attend school. Send to soyork@smsd.org



Students~~ Do you take medications during the day at school? Make sure that you bring them into the nurses office. They need to be in the original bottle with your name and current prescription.

From SMSD Health Services:

COVID Management for the 21-22 school year will look different from last year.

- SMSD COVID Team will notify JCDHE of all positive cases.
- JCDHE will manage all contact tracing and quarantine related to exposure to a positive case. In order to keep all students and staff safe at school please help us with the following:
 - Report all positive cases of COVID-19 to the school nurse.
 - Keep your student home when they are ill and get a PCR test.
 - PCR Testing – SMSD only accepts PCR COVID tests o SMSD offers free PCR testing Monday- Friday 8am-4pm when school is in session by calling 913-993-6218 o Free PCR testing is also offered at community testing sites such as www.gogettested.com/kansas, CVS, Walgreens, etc.
 - If you or your student have a known exposure to a positive case of COVID-19 outside of school/school related activity, please contact JCDHE at 913-715-2819 for instructions. Notification will be sent home at the elementary level if there is a positive case of COVID-19 in the grade level. This will assist parents in watching for symptoms within 14 days of exposure.

Due to high community transmission rates of COVID-19 in the county and lack of vaccine availability for all individuals, the Shawnee Mission School District (SMSD) will require masking of all children and adults in grades PreK-12 and in all district facilities until further notice.



August 5, 2021



MASKING:

Masks are required for all PreK-12 children and adults until such a time as all students have the opportunity to be fully vaccinated and community transmission levels decrease.

***Individuals do not need to mask when outdoors.** This includes students participating in elementary recess.



VACCINATIONS:

It is recommended that all eligible individuals receive the COVID-19 vaccination. Vaccination has proven to be the most effective means for individual protection against COVID-19 and in halting the transmission of COVID-19. It is strongly recommended that unvaccinated individuals continue to mask until fully vaccinated (2 weeks after the last dose in series).



EXCLUSION:

Fully vaccinated individuals will not be quarantined with an exposure unless they are/become symptomatic. COVID-19 positive individuals will be excluded from school/activities for 10 days and 24 hour symptom improvement.

CLASSLINK

GENERAL EDUCATION BUSING

Any student wanting to ride the general education bus must register with DS Bus Lines. This includes parent pay, those that qualify for free busing based on living 2.5 miles or more from their school, elementary school student living within a transportation variance, have Direct Certification letter, and those that qualify for free busing based on Household Economic Survey. As of July 19, 2021, we are advising Kansas School Districts that the CDC and the US Department of Health and Human Services current order which requires masks on school buses would apply based on the definition of conveyances. Conveyances also include other district vehicles such as activity buses, vans, SUVs, or cars, unless the driver is the sole occupant.
